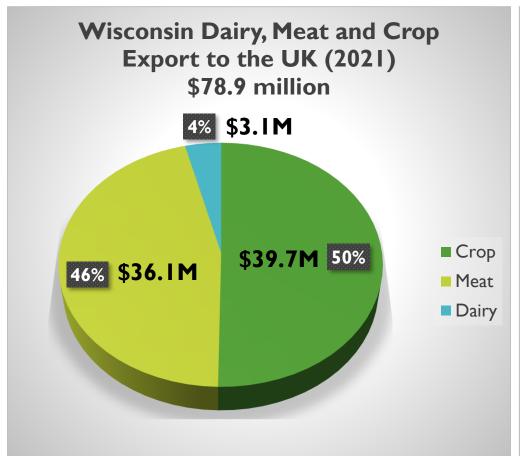


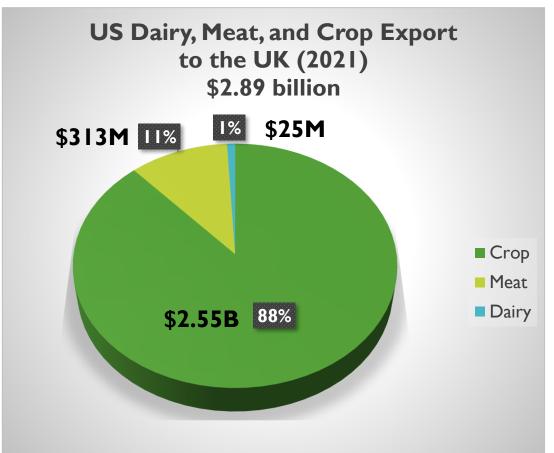

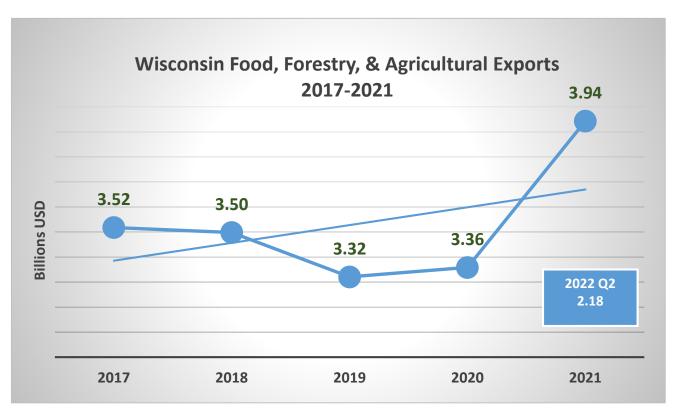

2022YTD Q2 Highlights

- 2022 Wisconsin exports
 \$2.18 billion, up 14.1% from 2021
- 2022 U.S. exports
 \$15 billion, up 15% from 2021
- 2021 Wisconsin exports (full year)
 \$3.94 billion all time high
- Five-year average (full year)\$3.53 billion



2022 DAIRY, MEAT, AND CROP PRODUCT EXPORTS \$2.18 BILLION, UP 14.1%

Top 5 Market Highlights

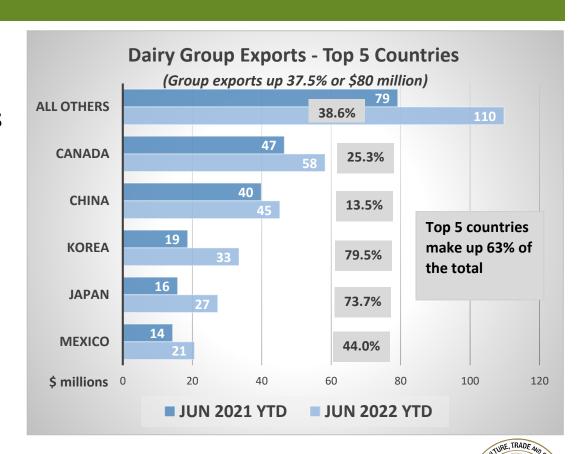
- 68% of the total
- Three of the five are up double digits to a total of \$1.47 billion
- Korea and Canada are up strongly
 - Driven by gains in beverages (including ethanol) and sauces in Canada. Korea main drivers are dairy, meat and sauces
- Wisconsin ranks 13th in the U.S. for dairy, meat, and crop product exports.



2022 YTD Q2 DAIRY PRODUCT EXPORTS \$295 MILLION, UP 37.5%

Dairy Product Highlights (up 37.5%)

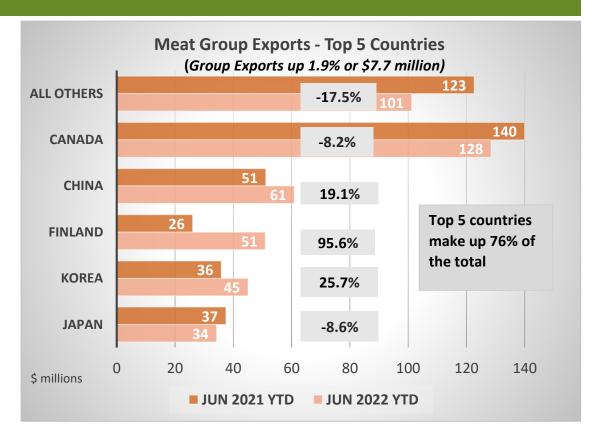
- 14% of all Wisconsin ag exports: Includes cheese, whey, lactose, and milk proteins.
- Top 5 products are 92% of the group total: Whey, Cheese and Curds are 58% of the total followed by Albumins, Lactose, Butter, Milk and others,
- Top 5 countries are 63% of the group total: All of the top five up double digits, led by Korea, Japan, and Mexico.



2022 YTD Q2 MEAT PRODUCT EXPORTS \$421 MILLION, UP 1.9%

Meat Product Highlights (up 1.9%)

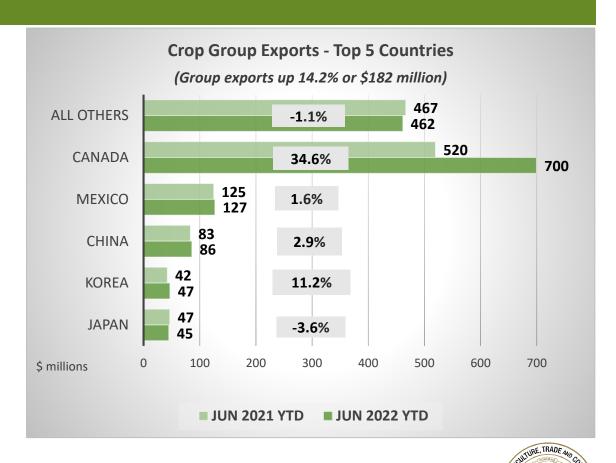
- I 9% of all Wisconsin ag exports:
 Includes livestock, genetics, hides, and furs.
- Top 5 products are 89% of the group total: Meat preparations and genetics are 50% of the total followed by offal, furskins, proteins, and all others.
- Top 5 countries are 72% of the group total: Three of the top five are up double digits, and two are down as well as all others. Finland is up due to mink pelt sales.



2022 YTD Q2 CROP PRODUCT EXPORTS \$2.69 BILLION, UP 14.2%

Crop Product Highlights (up 14.2%)

- 67% of all Wisconsin ag exports: Includes grains, forestry, processed foods, and beverages.
- Top 5 products are 55% of the group total: Beverages, prepared vegetables, and wood are a little over 50% of the total.
- Top 5 countries are 65% of the group total: Canada is up nearly 35% and Korea up 11%.

WI Ag Trade Mission to the United Kingdom (UK) | Planned for May – June 2023

- Opportunities for food, forestry, and agriculture products increase as BREXIT continues.
- Wood products, feed, livestock and genetics, craft spirits and beers, organic and specialty foods, and pet foods are among the products with the strongest opportunity.
- The mission will include buyer meetings, store visits, market briefings, and meetings with regulatory entities.
- Led by DATCP staff and will include meetings with national and regional government officials and industry and economic development organizations.
- WIAE funding will support the cost of up to six Wisconsin companies to participate.
- Dates and city locations will be released by January 2023.

Inbound Buyer Mission Food Products | **Planned for March – May 2023**

- Opportunity for Wisconsin companies to meet prospective buyers.
- Focus on dairy, meat, and crop products purchased by retailers, food service companies, and foreign food processing companies.
- Commodity groups representing the products made by the Wisconsin companies and
 agribusiness organizations are invited to assist by organizing receptions or hosted meals for
 the visiting buyers and the participating Wisconsin companies.
- WIAE funds will support up to 12 Wisconsin food product companies to participate.

Inbound Buyer Mission Forestry Products | **Planned for March – May 2023**

- DATCP will partner with the American Hardwoods Export Council and Softwoods
 Export Council to identify and recruit buyers from different countries.
- Timed to take place around a U.S. trade show or conference to maximize the number of buyers and minimize travel costs.
- WIAE funds will support up to 10 Wisconsin forestry products companies to participate.

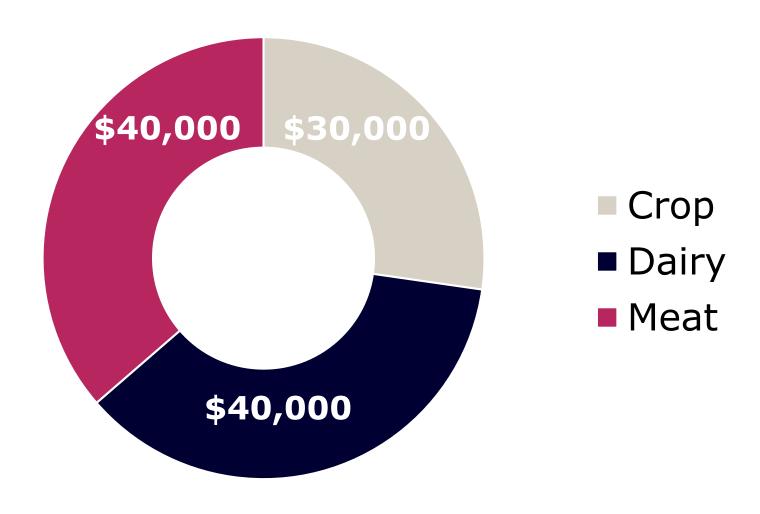
