LICENSE DENIAL: If a license application is denied, the applicant has the right to request a hearing concerning the denial. (ref. s. 227.42, Stats.) The request must be made in writing and must be received by the Department at the Central Office within 10 days after the applicant receives notice of denial. License fees are not refundable if a license application is denied.

REVIEW OF EQUIPMENT AND PLANS: Upon request by any dairy or food establishment, the Department's Division of Food Safety may review construction plans or equipment for compliance with applicable laws before a facility is constructed or equipment is installed. The Department may charge a fee to recover its cost for this review service, regardless of whether the review is required by law.(ref. s. 93.06(1w), Stats.)

SURCHARGE: Applicants found operating without a license within one year before submitting the license application shall pay a license fee surcharge.
