Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) Pesticide Certification



Commercial UAV Applicator

Get the proper FAA Credentialing

Get certified in a base category i.e) 1.1 Field and Vegetable

Get certified in 9.9 Aerial Application.

Once certified, apply for an annual Individual Commercial Applicators License.

Have a Pesticide Business License

Private UAV Applicator

Proper FAA Credentialing

Certified in a base category
i.e) 100 General Farming

Certified in 111.0 Aerial Application

If you are a private applicator and you do NOT apply Restricted Use Pesticides via UAV, then certification is NOT necessary.

REMEMBER:

Large UAV's (more than 55 lbs.) have additional FAA regulations compared to small UAV's (less than 55lbs.)

You must follow the label of the product you are using and make sure it does not prohibit aerial applications
