



**Total Acreage**

- The WI STS Program treated a total of approximately 233,857 acres at 82 sites in 23 counties.
- The WI DNR Suppression Program treated a total of approximately 2,885 acres at 37 sites in 8 counties.
- Total acres in each program include all treatments it conducted: Btk, NPV (Gypchek) and mating disruption.

**Aerial Spraying  
Timeframe**

- STS began May 23 and ended July 19.
- Suppression began May 24 and ended June 2.

**Treatment Details**

- Btk STS treatments were applied once or twice to approximately 53,852 acres.
- Btk Suppression treatments were applied once to approximately 2,285 acres.
- STS: Btk applications started on May 23 and ended June 13.
- Suppression: Btk applications started on May 24 and ended June 2.
- NPV by STS was applied to approximately 2,577 acres.
- NPV by Suppression was applied to approximately 600 acres.
- NPV applications were done between May 23 and June 2.
- Mating disruption by STS was applied to approximately 177,158 acres.
- Mating disruption applications started June 28 and July 19.
- Suppression does not conduct any mating disruption applications.

- Jackson and Price counties were added to the quarantine.

**Trapping**

- A total of 233,990 moths were caught.
- More than 25,000 traps were set in 48 counties, mainly in western and central Wisconsin.
- Trapping grids were set on a 1-mile, 2-mile and 3-mile grid.
- Delimitation blocks were set at 4 per square mile and 9 per square mile.
- No counties reported a zero catch.

**Egg Mass  
Surveys**

- Egg mass surveys in 29 non-regulated counties began in mid-October and ended in early November.
- 469 sites covering approximately 2,000 acres were surveyed.
- 65 sites were identified as having alternate life stages (egg masses, pupa shells, cast skins) present in 18 of the surveyed counties.
- Trappers and landowners reported an additional 25 positive sites during the trapping season.
