

Wisconsin Agricultural Export Highlights

January 2017 – December 2017

Highlights


- Wisconsin exported \$3.5 billion in agricultural products to 147 countries in 2017, an increase of 3.63 percent in value compared to the same period last year.
- Wisconsin currently ranks 12th among U.S. states in agricultural exports.
- Wisconsin ranked first in the export of ginseng roots, prepared/preserved cranberries, sweet corn prepared/preserved, and bovine semen. Wisconsin ranked second in the export of whey, cheese and raw furskins.
- Exports of dairy, eggs and honey products* in 2017 were valued at \$297 million, a 19.9 percent increase compared to the same period last year. Wisconsin now ranks fifth among U.S. states in the export of these products.
- Total U.S. agricultural exports were valued at \$167 billion, an increase of 3.3 percent compared to the same period last year.
- Total Wisconsin exports, including manufactured goods, were valued at \$22.3 billion, a 6 percent increase from the same period last year.
