To obtain a blanket import permit, I agree to do the following for all CVIs (certificates of veterinary inspection) for swine being sent to Wisconsin:

- Include a statement on the CVI and import permit disclosing the PRRS status of the herd (if known):
 - ♦ If the status of the herd is unknown, write on the CVI and permit application “PRRS herd status unknown.”
 - ♦ If the status of the herd is known, the status will be identified by the categories “PRRS Positive” or “PRRS Negative.”
- Include a statement on the CVI that the animals have not been vaccinated against pseudorabies.
- Include the livestock premises code for Wisconsin buyers, if available, for animals shipped to Wisconsin.
- **On the first business day after the sale**, I will a) fax all CVIs for Wisconsin-bound swine to (608) 224-4871, b) scan and email all CVIs to DATCPAnimalImports@Wisconsin.gov, or c) call (608) 224-4874 to tell the import coordinator that no animals from the sale will be entering Wisconsin (whichever is applicable).

BLANKET SWINE ONLY IMPORT PERMIT APPLICATION INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY

A blanket import permit can only be issued in the following situations when a general or regular import permit cannot be obtained:

1. A veterinarian at an out-of-state sale held on dates the DAH is not open for business anticipates possible Wisconsin purchases and imports.
2. A Wisconsin importer anticipates a possible out-of-state purchase and animal importation at times the DAH is not open for business.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. For *applicants who are veterinarians*, the following information must be provided on this form:
 - The date of sale.
 - The veterinarian's name; trade name, if applicable; address, including city, state and zip; and telephone number.
 - The seller's name; trade name, if applicable; address, including city, state and zip; telephone number; and livestock premises code, if known.
2. For *applicants who are Wisconsin importers*, the following information must be provided on this form:
 - The approximate date of possible purchase or import.
 - The importer's name; trade name, if applicable; address, including city, state and zip; and telephone number.
 - The state from which a purchase may be made.
 - If known, the seller's name; trade name, if applicable; address, including city state and zip; telephone number; and livestock premises code.
3. In this application, "seller" means the owner of the swine being sold or the market location at which the swine is being sold, whichever is applicable.
