# ANNUAL REPORT

## 2020 WISCONSIN COUNTY AND DISTRICT FAIRS

### INTRODUCTION

The 2020 Fair season in Wisconsin was unusual, as it was across the nation. As fairs were planned, cancelled, or modified, DATCP personnel worked with the fairs to help provide the best resources so each fair could determine what their 2020 fair would look like for all involved from their exhibitors, vendors, workers, carnivals, service clubs and entertainers to their patrons.

In 2020, fifty-three (71 percent) of the Wisconsin Fairs were cancelled. The remaining twenty-two fairs (29%) were modified in some way. The Wisconsin Association of Fairs classified this past summer's fairs into three categories. These included: Fairs modified, but still open to the public; Fairs Modified and open to exhibitors only; and fairs cancelled for 2020.

The majority of the counties that cancelled their fairs in 2020 did just that. There were no exhibits, exhibitors, judging, midway, entertainment or activities of any kind. Most of the fairs in this category were able to postpone their midway and entertainment to the 2021 fair. Some of these fairs have done some type of fundraisers such as drive through fair food stands and others doing drive through meals. All of these activities were done with safety protocols in mind and enforced.

### EXHIBITS AND EXHIBITORS

Fairs bring producers and consumers together and unite rural and urban people in an educational and entertaining community activity. An essential part of this process is showcasing thousands of exhibits by youth and adults. The major emphasis continues to be on youth and educational exhibits.

In 2019, over 36,000 junior youth exhibitors brought 237,071 entries to county and district fairs. Only 5,760 junior youth exhibitors were able to participate in fair competition in 2020.

### JUNIOR AND OPEN DIVISION PREMIUMS

The amount of premium dollars paid to Junior, Open and Senior Citizen classes showed a sharp decline from \$767,803 in 2019 to \$92,340 in 2020. Of this amount, \$73,057 went to junior exhibitors. The top departments in premiums paid, for exhibitors in junior and open class were:

In the junior division, the largest total premiums paid in 2020 were mainly in animal classes. The largest was the Swine department, totaling \$9,647; Dairy was next with \$8,894, followed by Beef with \$8,805 and Horses at \$5,304. Other junior fair departments ranked in order of premiums paid were: Poultry, Cultural Arts, Photography and Sheep.

### FUNCTION OF COUNTY AND DISTRICT FAIRS

Fairs and festivals are spending more time to develop fun and educational agricultural displays where volunteers interact with fairgoers of all ages. The first objective of every fair is to present a teaching/learning experience, done in such a way to be enjoyed by all ages. Serving as a showplace for the community, fairs offer informational exhibits, big name entertainment at low prices, free stage entertainment, and the opportunity for youth and adults to work together. Throughout the years, county fairs have not only adjusted their focus to changes in agriculture and technology, but have also assumed a role of leadership in helping these changes fit the needs of their community.

Many of the Wisconsin 74 county and district fairs are becoming more involved with the IAFE (International Association of Fairs & Expos). As members, they enter various contests for advertising and promotional events and are developing ways to promote Agricultural Education to all fairgoers in an interesting and fun way. Many of the Wisconsin County Fairs, along with the Wisconsin State Fair, have won national awards.

### STATE AID INFORMATION

#### Source and Amount of Funds

The source of funds for the 2020 county fair aids comes from General Purpose Revenue. The uniform premium list, as established in ATCP 160 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, provides the basis for the distribution of \$456,400 made available for premium aid to county and district fairs.

There were 22 fairs that requested state aid in 2020. The amount available could not be utilized, therefore \$369,480.58 was returned to the State. Each request was fully funded according to the formula in statute and no pro-rata subtraction was needed from each fair's request.

### **Distribution of State Aid**

State aid is paid on a revised formula established in 2007 by the Legislature. Section 20.115(4) (b) Wis. Stats. Premiums are paid to Junior, Open and Senior Citizen classes, with a \$10,000 maximum for each fair. Section 93.23(1) (a) directs money to be paid to fairs by request only. State aid paid to each fair is based on premiums paid in the current fair season.

### **FAIR PROMOTIONAL PROJECTS**

#### **Fairs Entertainment Schedule**

The Fairs Entertainment Schedule is a promotional tool listing entertainment for every day at every fair in Wisconsin. It is printed and distributed in a cooperative effort by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection and the Wisconsin Association of Fairs. In 2020, no schedule was printed and all information regarding fair was regularly updated on the Wisconsin Association of Fairs (WAF) website.
