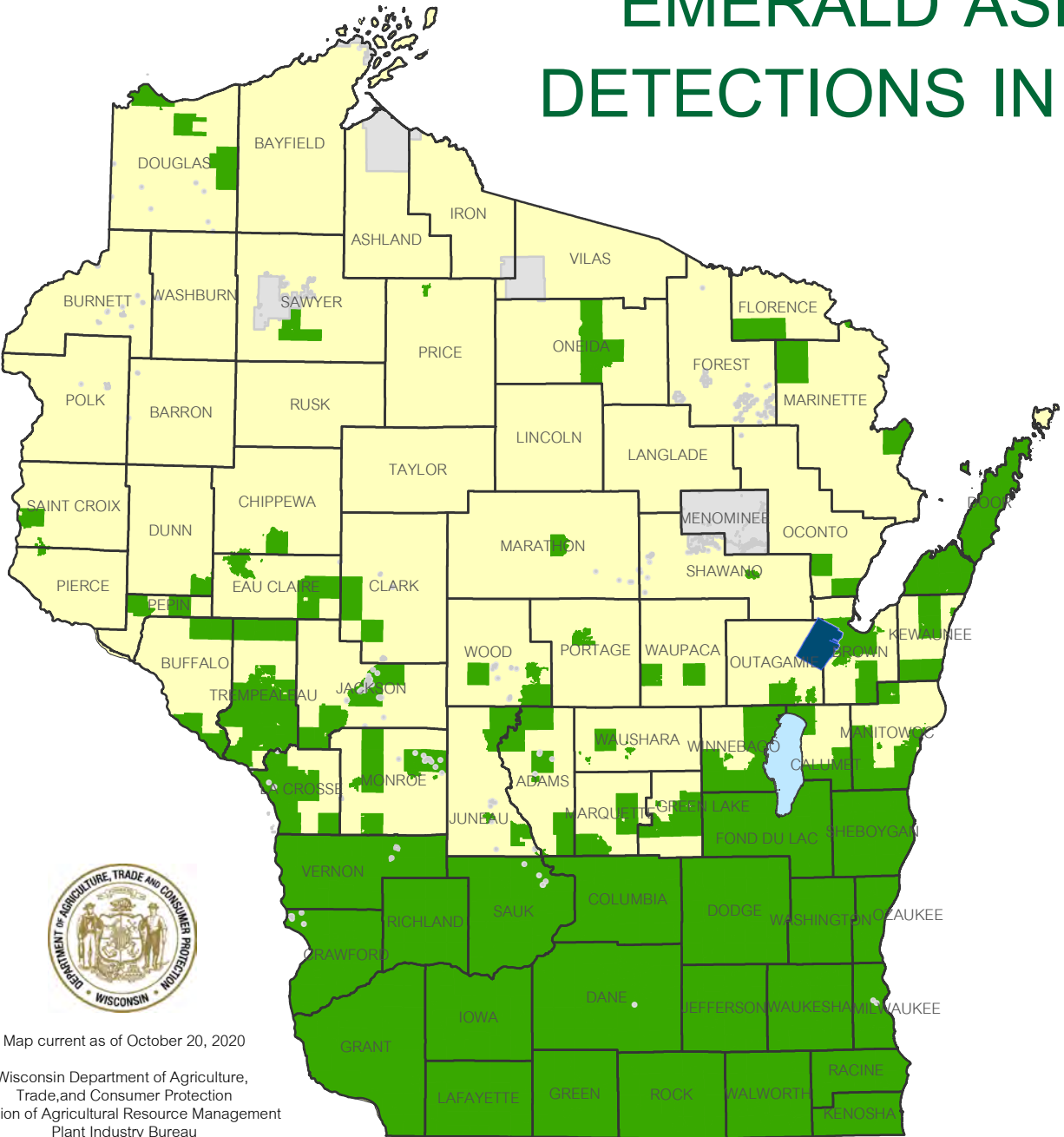






EMERALD ASH BORER DETECTIONS IN WISCONSIN

While all of Wisconsin is part of the Federal Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) Quarantine, most of the state remains EAB-free as shown in yellow on the map. EAB has been confirmed only within the municipal boundaries colored green. By limiting the transport of firewood and adhering to firewood regulations and federal and tribal quarantines, we can slow down artificial spread of EAB.
