Service Company Requirement

A service company that installs, services, tests or calibrates weighing or measuring devices is required to have a weights and measures service company license issued by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP). Farm milk tanks are a measuring device.

To apply for a Wisconsin weights and measures service company license, you must complete form [TR-WM-54](#).

Service Technician Requirement

In addition to the company license, a registered service technician working for a licensed service company is required to test, service or calibrate farm milk tanks.

To become a registered service technician, you must pass a DATCP exam. To register for an exam, complete form [TR-WM-81](#) and submit it to DATCP with the required fee. Study materials for the exam include NIST Handbook 44: General Code Sec.1.10 and the Farm Milk Tank Code Sec 4.42.
