Farm Milk Tank Service Company Licenses & Technician Registration

Service Company Requirement

Wis. Adm. Code s. ATCP 92.20

Farm Milk Tanks are weights and measures devices. A service company that installs, services, tests or calibrates weights and measures devices is required to have an annual license that expires each year on December 31.

Service Technician Requirement

Wis. Adm. Code s. ATCP 92.21

A service company technician is defined as anyone that tests, services or calibrates a weights and measures device. A Farm Milk Tank is a weights and measures device and therefore requires a registered service technician to test, service or calibrate the device. Technicians must register and pay a fee for an exam. Study materials for the exam include NIST Handbook 44: General Code Sec.1.10 and the Farm Milk Tank Code Sec 4.42. These can be downloaded at <http://www.nist.gov/pml/wmd/pubs/handbooks.cfm>.
