STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

For improved feed efficiency and increased rate of weight gain in cattle fed in confinement for slaughter.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

Lasalocid	30.00	grams/ton	or	15.00 mg/pound
Diflubenzuron	3.35	grams/ton	or	1.67 mg/pound

USE DIRECTIONS

Feed continuously in complete feed to provide not less than 250 mg nor more than 360 mg/head/day.

Feed to supply diflubenzuron at a rate of 0.1 mg/2.2 lbs body wt/day as indicated in the left most chart below. If the Lasalocid chart is blank for the lasalocid level in the feed, it cannot be fed to animals of that weight; it will over or under medicate.
