FDA revises facility registration process for Chile, China and the EU

As per the US Dairy Export Council, the FDA has revised the process for new applications and biennial updates to the list of facilities eligible for export to Chile, China and the EU. Applications will now be done electronically on the new [FDA Unified Registration and Listing Systems \(FURLS\) Dairy Listing Module \(DLM\)](#).

Facilities must submit a separate application for each destination: Chile, China and the EU. Chilean registration requires the most immediate attention. All facilities currently listed on the milk product list for Chile or wishing to ship to Chile must complete an application on the [DLM](#) by **August 22**.

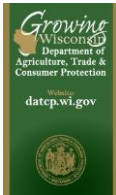
