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Dear Wisconsin Children's Safety Advocates:

In July 2020, the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission issued a total of **14 recalls relating to products affecting children**. Attached is a summary of the releases identifying the product, the problem, and what should be done with the recalled product.

We have found that not all of the recalls are picked up by the news media as they occur. This monthly summary will give you the opportunity to review all of the children's product safety recalls for the past month. If you are interested in a complete text of the recall, click on the hyperlink at the end of the recall description. This will direct you to the recall notice located on the CPSC website.

KEEP YOUR KIDS SAFE

Release Number: (#20-144) Boy Scouts of America, of Charlotte, N.C., is announcing the voluntary recall of about 78,000 Cub Scout activity pins. This recall involves Boy Scouts of America's Cub Scout outdoor activity pins. The rhomboid-shaped pin is silver with a gold animal paw painted on a blue background.

Problem: The pin's face and shaft contain levels of lead that exceed the federal lead content ban. Lead is toxic if ingested by young children and can cause adverse health issues.

What to do: Consumers should immediately take the recalled pin away from children and return the pin to any Boy Scouts of America retail store or contact Boy Scout of America's National Distribution Center for a full refund, including shipping, or for a merchandise credit. Consumers can contact Boy Scouts of America at 800-323-0736 from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. ET Monday through Friday or online at www.scoutshop.org and click on "Product Recall" at the bottom of the page for more information.

Release Number: (#20-754) Avalon Furniture, of Houston, Texas, is announcing the voluntary recall of about 9,500 Cottage Town bedroom furniture collection. This recall involves the Cottage Town Bedroom Furniture Collection, manufactured by Avalon Furniture, which was sold in white, black, and gray colors. The recalled furniture includes the dresser, mirror, king headboard, king footboard, queen headboard, queen footboard, chest, and gent's chest, manufactured between August 1, 2019 and December 18, 2019. A full list of SKU numbers can be found online.

Problem: The base coat paint used on pieces within the furniture collection contains levels of lead that exceed the federal lead paint standard. Lead is toxic if ingested by young children and can cause adverse health effects.

What to do: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled furniture and contact Rooms To Go for free replacement and free pickup of the furniture. Rooms To Go is contacting all known purchasers directly. Consumers will not be responsible for shipping costs. Release Number: (#20-755) North Woods General Store LLS, d/b/a A Better You!, of Hebron, Ky., is announcing the voluntary recall of about 750 Belecoo 535-S baby strollers. This recall involves Belecoo 535-S convertible baby strollers sold in black, pink, blue, khaki and gray colors. The strollers convert into carriages in the bassinet position. Belecoo is printed on the stroller's frame and on the shoulder straps. The model number 535-S is printed on a label on the inside of the rear frame of the stroller.

Problem: The recalled strollers violate the federal Carriages and Strollers standard. A child's torso can pass through the opening between the activity tray and the seat bottom and his/her head can become entrapped, posing entrapment and strangulation hazards. The location of the crotch restraint creates a large opening between the seat bottom and the restraint, and it can become detached, posing a fall hazard to children.

What to do: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled baby stroller and contact A Better You! for instructions on how to receive a full refund including taxes and original shipping cost. Release Number: (#20-756) Edens Garden, of San Clemente, Calif., is announcing the voluntary recall of about 8,200 Edens Garden 100% pure wintergreen and birch essential oil. This recall involves 100% Pure Wintergreen and Birch Essential Oils in amber glass bottles with black caps. The essential oils were sold in 5 mL, 10 mL, 30 mL and 4 fl. oz. The volume amount of the bottle is printed on the label. The Edens Garden logo is printed in black and the product name is printed in white.

Problem: The products contain the substance methyl salicylate which must be in child resistant packaging as required by the Poison Prevention Packaging Act (PPPA). The packaging of the products are not child resistant, posing a risk of poisoning if the contents are swallowed by young children.

Release Number: (#20-762) Bexco Enterprises, dba DaVinci, of Pico Rivera, Calif., is announcing the voluntary recall of about 3,000 DaVinci Bailey Bassinets. This recall involves wooden DaVinci Bailey Bassinets for infants. The recalled bassinets were sold in the following four colors, with corresponding product numbers – gray (M0934G), espresso (M0934E), natural (M0934N) and white (M0934W). The model number “0934” is printed on a white label attached to the mattress support board and on the external product package. The assembled bassinets measure 38 inches long by 20 inches wide by 30 inches high, and each weighs about 21 pounds. The bassinets were sold with a 1-inch waterproof cradle pad. “DaVinci” is printed on the product packaging, instruction manual and product registration card.

Problem: The bassinet’s mattress support can become disengaged, posing fall and entrapment hazards to babies.

What to do: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled bassinets and contact DaVinci for a free repair kit that will reinforce the mattress support. In the meantime, parents are urged to find an alternate, safe sleeping environment for the child, such as a crib that meets current safety standards. Release Number: (#20-149) Crate and Barrel, of Northbrook, Ill., is announcing the voluntary recall of about 2,440 Parke twin and full beds. This recall involves Crate and Barrel Parke model twin and full platform beds with a wood headboard and frame. The following SKU numbers and colors are included in the recall. The SKU number and “Crate and Barrel” and “Parke” are printed on the bed’s headboard.

Problem: The headboard on the recalled beds can separate from the side rails, posing a fall hazard.

Release Number: (#20-150) Rocky Mountain Bicycles, of Canada, is announcing the voluntary recall of about 1,530 Rocky Mountain non-electric alloy frame Instinct, Instinct BC and Pipeline bicycles. This recall includes the alloy models of Rocky Mountain model year 2018-2020 Instinct, Instinct BC and Pipeline trail bikes. Rocky Mountain is printed on the downtube. Instinct, Instinct BC or Pipeline are printed inside the seatstay on the left hand side. The bikes were sold with 29 inch and 27.5+ inch wheels.

The recalled bikes include small, medium and large sizes with serial numbers starting with PRK17, PRK18 and PRK19-XXXXX. The serial number is located under the bottom frame bracket. Only non-electric bicycles with alloy frames in all colors models and serial numbers can be found online.

Problem: The bicycle’s front frame triangle can crack and cause separation of the head tube from the frame, posing fall and injury hazards.

What to do: Consumers should stop using the recalled bicycles immediately and contact Rocky Mountain for information on how to receive a free replacement front triangle.
