Notarization is not required unless cost-share contracts are recorded

When landowners, grant recipients and their spouse are required to sign a cost-share contract, **it is <u>not necessary to notarize</u>** their signatures unless the cost-share contract must be recorded at the register of deeds for one of the following reasons:

- 1. The contract exceeds \$14,000 in DATCP cost-sharing for engineered¹ or non-engineered² conservation practices. Sec. <u>ATCP 50.40(14)(a)</u>
 - a. This requirement does not apply to conservation practices listed in sec. s. <u>ATCP</u> <u>50.08 (5) (b)</u>³ Sec. <u>ATCP 50.40(14)(c)</u>
- 2. The county intends to voluntarily record the contract at the register of deeds. Sec. <u>ATCP</u> 50.40(14)(d)
- 3. The contract includes an agreement or easement involving an interest in land, and a payment is made for:
 - a. Land out of production. Sec. ATCP 50.40(18)
 - b. CREP equivalent for riparian land taken out of production (by 15 year agreement or an easement). Sec. <u>ATCP 50.08(4)</u>
