

## **Food & Meat CD Introduction.**

The CD-Rom you have purchased contains two files. The ReadMe file that you are looking at and a SelectLocationLicenses file.

The data in this file is refreshed and available on the first business day of each month.

Please read this file before attempting to use the data.

### **Software Recommendation**

These files have been tested with MicroSoft Office 97 and Lotus Smart Suite 97. Versions of these software packages or higher can be used to access the license files. In addition, software that can read .csv files may be used to access the files.

### **Accessing the License File**

The SelectLocationLicenses file contains all active licensed Dairy Plants, Retail Food Establishments, Food Processors, Food Warehouses and Meat Plants, with operation and product codes where applicable, selected from the Department's licensing database on the first of every month. The files are comma delimited, have column headers and a file type of CSV. This allows the file to be opened directly by spreadsheet applications such as Microsoft Excel. The data can also be loaded into a database program. **Be sure to set the file type to All Files before trying to open the files on the CD-ROM.**

Most fields are enclosed with double quotes ( " ") to allow for commas and special characters to be included as part of the data. The double quotes provide proper field placement when opening the file with a spreadsheet.

The files can also be opened with a text editor such as NotePad.

These files can be used to create Mail Merge documents or mailing labels.

### **Data Selection**

Lists can be selected by any of the data fields included in the file. Type, Type and Sub Code, Zip Code are some logical selection criteria. Info Codes can also be used to select lists. If you want a list of all bakeries you would select Info Code 2010. Three different license types can perform a bakery operation. Location Licenses may also contain the county code.

### **Use of Information**

The department does not restrict how the data is used or the number of times the data is used. **It is the purchaser's responsibility to extract and format the data for use.** Please consult the yellow pages for a business in your locality if you require help extracting and formatting data for use. Businesses that may provide help can be found under the headings of: Copying and Duplicating Services, Computer Services or Mailing Services.
