## **Health Services Staff Qualifications**

For Rec-Ed Camps within 15 Minutes of Emergency Medical Services

Each camp must have one person who has completed a first aid and CPR course. Persons holding a current certificate of completion for an approved basic first aid course and an approved professional CPR-AED course may serve as health services staff for a camp, if all of the following conditions exist:

- Emergency medical services (EMS) can respond to an incident at the camp in 15 minutes or less. EMS must state this in writing.
- There is a telephone to contact EMS that meets all of the following:
  - o Does not use coins.
  - o Is accessible at all times during camp operation.
  - o Is close to the camp buildings or lodging units.
