Schwai's Meat & Sausage Market Issues Voluntary Class III Recall of Fresh Bratwurst

Schwai's Meat & Sausage Market in Fredonia, WI, is issuing a voluntary class III recall for fresh bratwurst due to the amount of water added to the product. The water added exceeds the limit for fresh sausage standards. The recalled products include:

- Fresh bratwurst, 2-pound packages sold at retail stores in Fredonia, Cedarburg, and the West Bend Farmers Market.

This is a Class III recall, initiated based on evidence collected during a routine inspection conducted by state food safety staff. USDA Recall Classifications

Class I	This is a health hazard situation where there is a reasonable probability that the use of the product will cause serious, adverse health consequences or death.
Class II	This is a health hazard situation where there is a remote probability of adverse health consequences from the use of the product.
Class III	This is a situation where the use of the product will not cause adverse health consequences.
