- You may not inspect a tank system that is regulated under Wisconsin Administrative Code [ATCP 93](#) for the purpose of administering and enforcing [ATCP 93](#) unless you hold a tank system inspector certification issued by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP).
- Your responsibilities as a tank system inspector include the following:
 - Perform regulatory enforcement of related code requirements in ATCP 93 and SPS 305
 - Issue noncompliance or violation corrective orders and conduct follow-up inspections as necessary
 - Pursue failure to comply with corrective orders through local or departmental enforcement referral procedures
 - Maintain a record of the inspections made, including the dates and the findings of the inspections
 - Provide a copy of the inspection report to the owner of the tank system or his/her agent
 - Make your inspection records available to DATCP upon request
- To initially obtain a Tank System Inspector Certification, you must complete a training program approved by DATCP. Currently, the only approved training course is offered by Lakeshore Technical College (LTC). Additional information on the course is available at their website here: <http://gotoltc.edu/>. This course is open to the public; however, only those authorized to perform regulatory enforcement, such as state employees or local program operators acting as agents of the department, will be issued a Tank System Inspector credential.
- You are initially required to pass the Tank System Inspector Certification exam administered by LTC at the end of the training course. DATCP will notify you of your exam score by mail within 21 calendar days of the date of the exam.
- If you pass the exam, the notification we send will include the Tank System Inspector Certification application and a Social Security Form that must be returned to us along with a \$50 certification fee within 3 months of the date of our request. If you are a veteran, you may be eligible for a DVA voucher to cover the cost of this fee. Please contact the DVA at 1-800-WisVets or online at www.WisVets.com for more information.
- Your Tank System Inspector Certification is valid for 2 years from the date of issue.
- In order to renew your Certification without having to re-take the training course and exam at LTC, you are required to obtain 12 continuing education credits from a certified provider prior to the expiration of your Certification.
