RE: Creation of ATCP 21 ad-hoc Advisory Committee - Amendment

I am writing to notify you of the Plant Industry Bureau's creation of the ATCP 21 ad-hoc Advisory Committee ("Committee") related to considering modifications to plant pest control rules, pursuant to Wis. Stat. s. 227.13.

The [Scope Statement](#) (SS115-20) for ATCP 21 was approved by the Governor on August 13, 2020, and approved by the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection Board on November 19, 2020. The objective of the Committee is to advise the Bureau on the proposed modification of rule language related to plant protection rules for invasive pests and diseases, including considering the removal of state quarantine regulations for emerald ash borer, pine shoot beetle and thousand cankers disease; the addition of state quarantine rules for balsam woolly adelgid, elongate hemlock scale, and spotted lanternfly, adding Alaska to the infested range for the hemlock woolly adelgid import regulations; and updating the host list for *Phytophthora ramorum*.

The Department submitted a notice of the formation of the Committee on February 23, 2021. This notice is an update to revise the member representing the Wisconsin Tribal Conservation Advisory Council (WTCAC) from "Lacey Hill-Kastern," who has left the organization, to two WTCAC staffers, "(Jeff Mears and Nathan Podany)," to facilitate ongoing tribal input.
