SUBJECT: ATCP 29, Public Hearing on Scope Statement- Rule Changes to Update Alignment to Federal Regulations (Pesticide Use and Control)

REQUESTED ACTION:

At the July 11, 2024 Board meeting, the Department will request approval to hold a preliminary public hearing on the Statement of Scope, regarding ch. ATCP 29 (Rule changes to update alignment of Administrative Code Chapter ATCP 29 to revisions within Title 40 of the U.S. Code of Federal Regulations, Part 171).

SUMMARY:

On May 23, 2024, the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules (JCRAR) requested DATCP to hold a preliminary public hearing and comment period on Scope Statement SS 045-24, which was published in the Wisconsin Administrative Register on May 13, 2024. The Department proposes to hold a preliminary public hearing on SS 045-24 on Monday July 29, 2024, at 9:00AM.

The department proposes to amend ATCP 29 to update pesticide categories for commercial and private applicators, update minimum age requirements to get certified for commercial and private applicators, update pesticide core standards descriptions for commercial and private applicators, update recordkeeping requirements for commercial applicators, and update recordkeeping requirements for Restricted Use Dealers. As per Wisconsin Statute Section 94.705, DATCP has statutory authority over pesticides (certification requirements and standards). Wisconsin Statute Section 94.705(2) requires that the department adopt standards at least equal to, but not exceeding, Federal Standards. Wisconsin Statute Section 94.705(3) requires records maintained by commercial applicators to be kept for two years, and to be open for inspection by the department or cooperating governmental enforcement agencies.
