Pilot initiated in February 2022.

Currently 7 organizations in the pilot.

- 4 – Grade A dairy plants.
- 3 – Grade B dairy plants.
- 1 – tech service company.

1 initial participant voluntarily dropped from the pilot.

Status of Pilot:

- All organizations have been enrolled in UW-Madison's virtual training course.
- 3 applications have been received and processed.
- OJT has been started by the division with the applicants.
