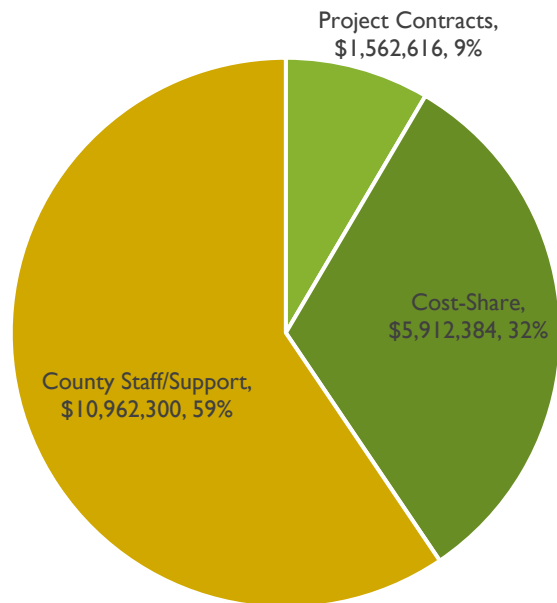
REPORT HAS A NEW LOOK

- Highlighted 8 counties: Ashland, Brown, Juneau, La Crosse, Manitowoc, Marathon, Outagamie, and Washington

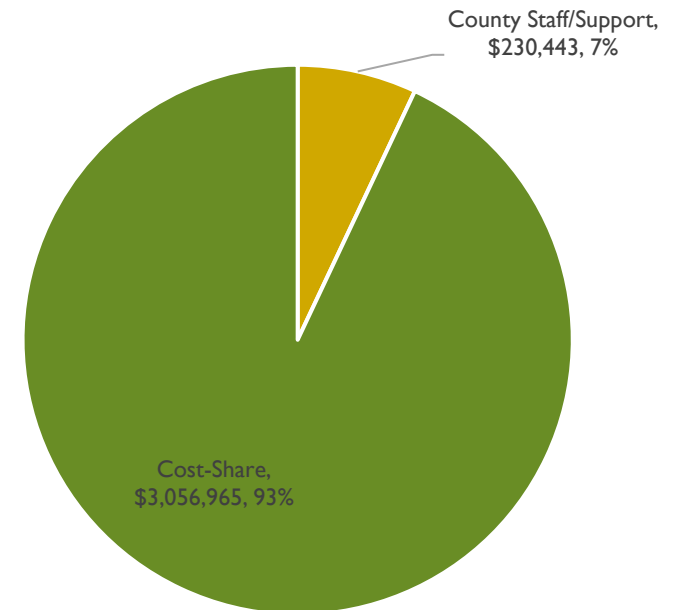


CONSERVATION FUNDING - \$21,724,708

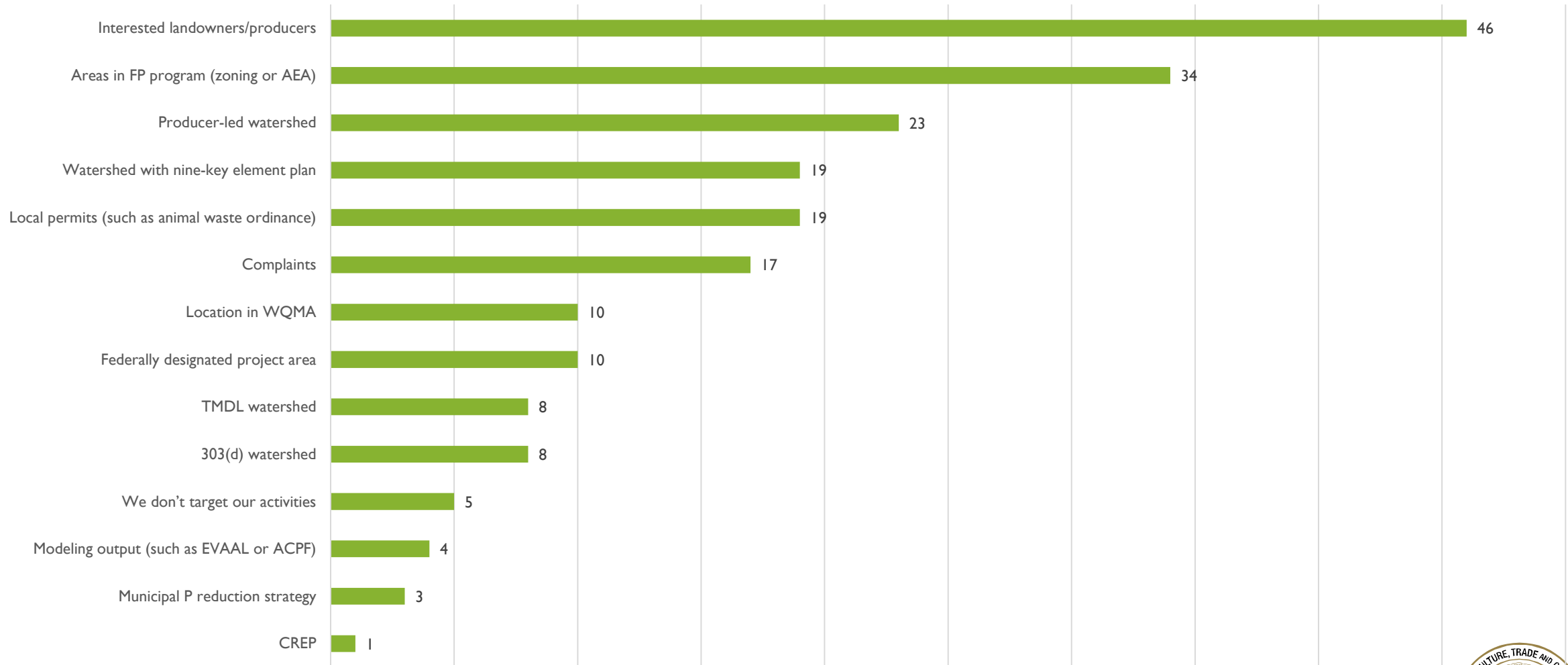
DATCP Funds - \$18,437,300



DNR Funds - \$3,287,408

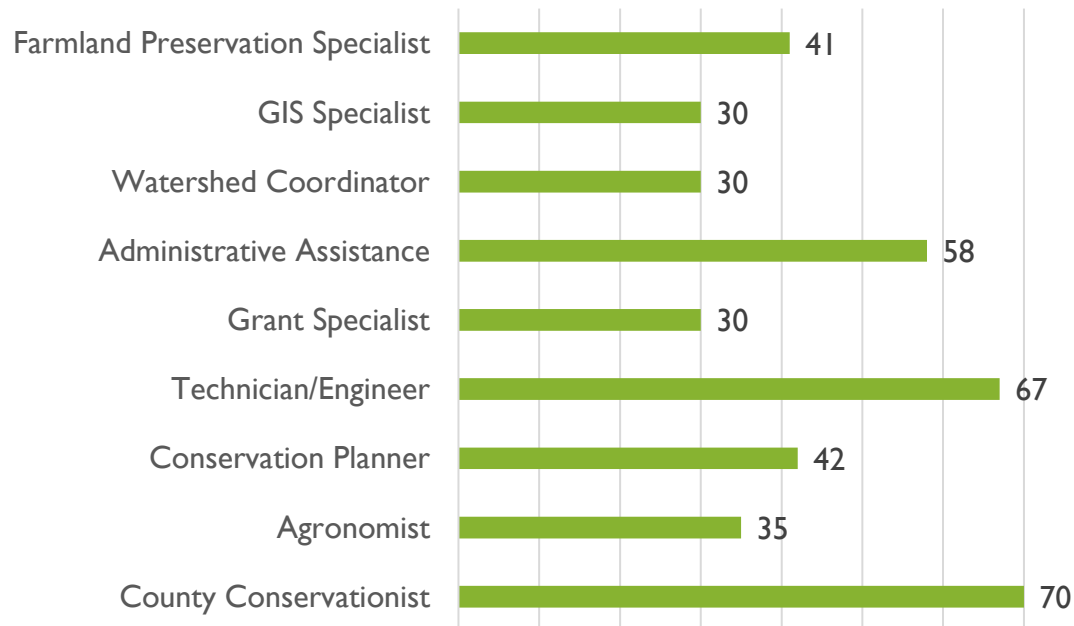


Top Strategies to Target Conservation Practices in 2024

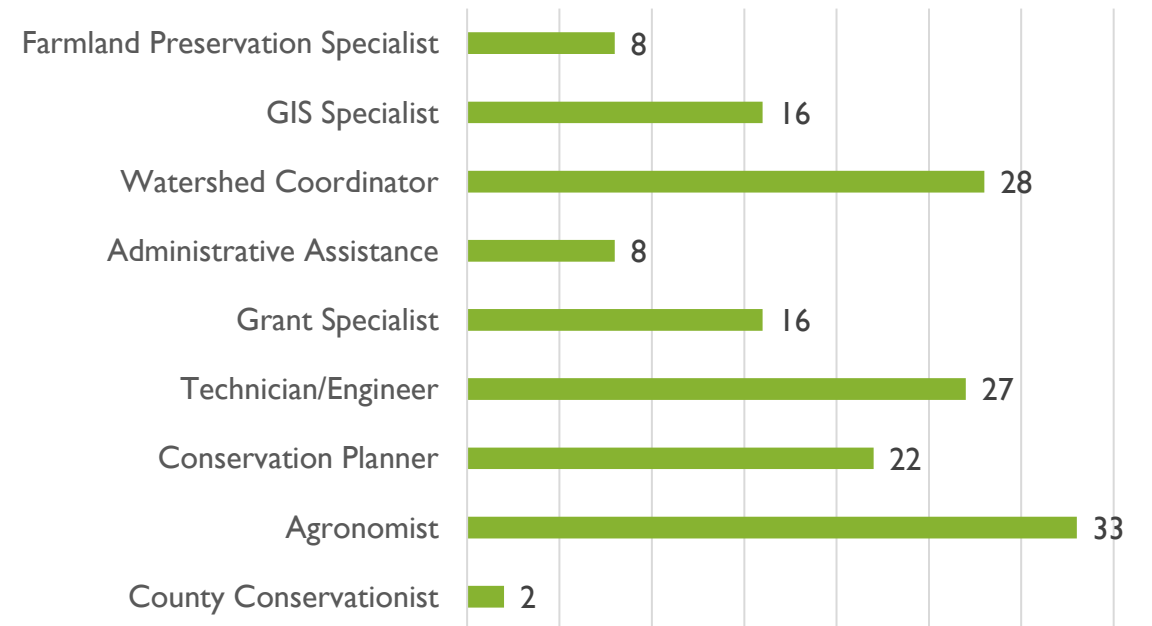

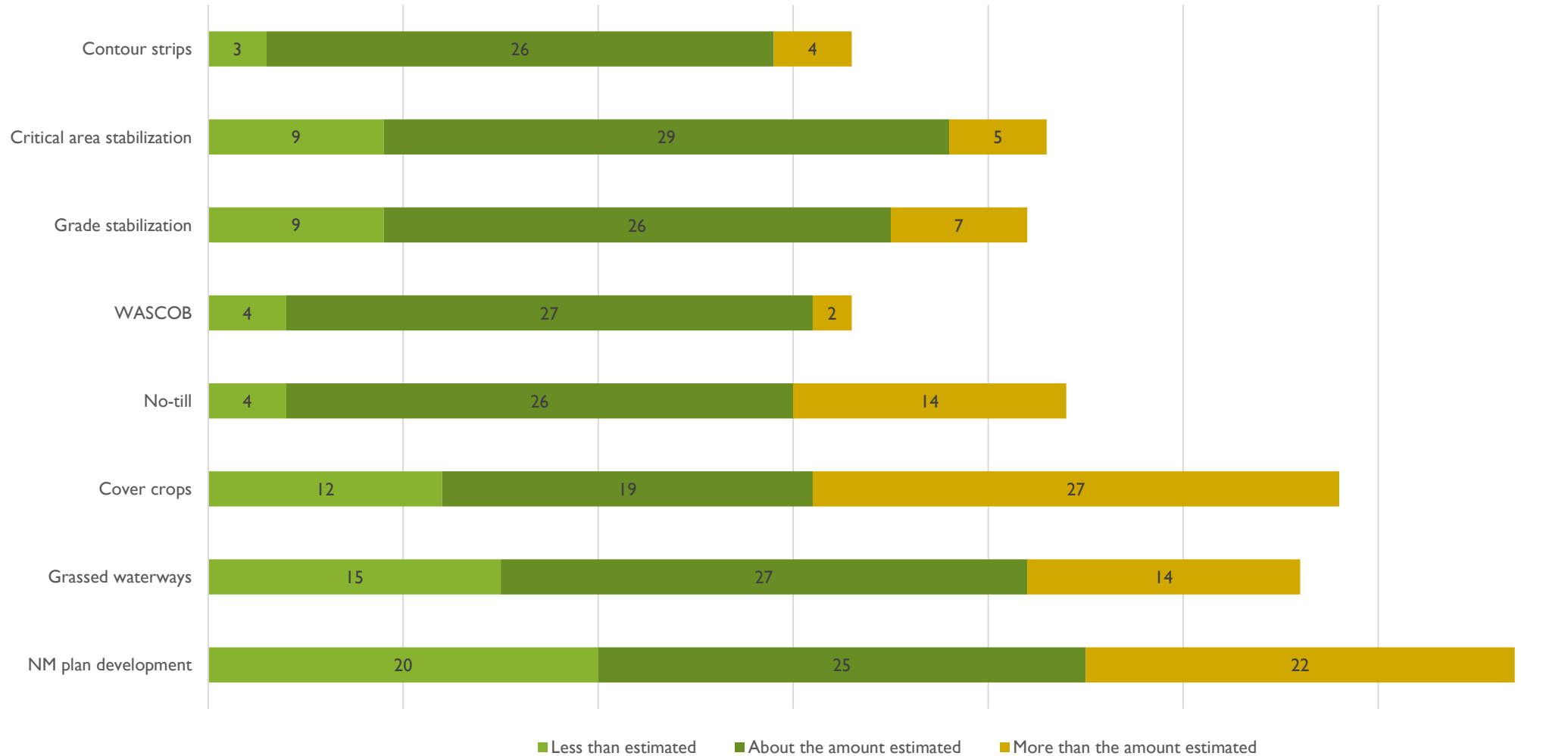
Existing County Staff Expertise



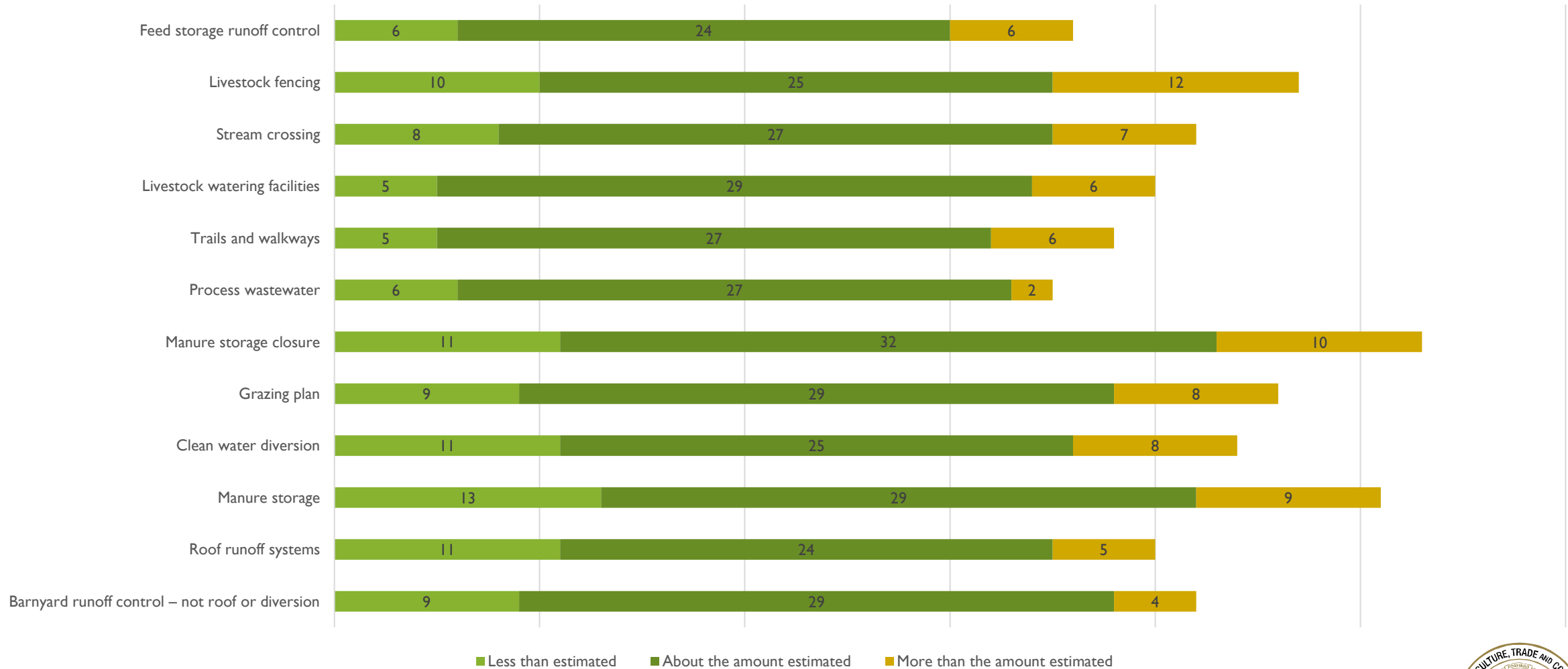
County Staff Expertise Needs



Cropland Practices Installed, Compared to Workplan Estimates

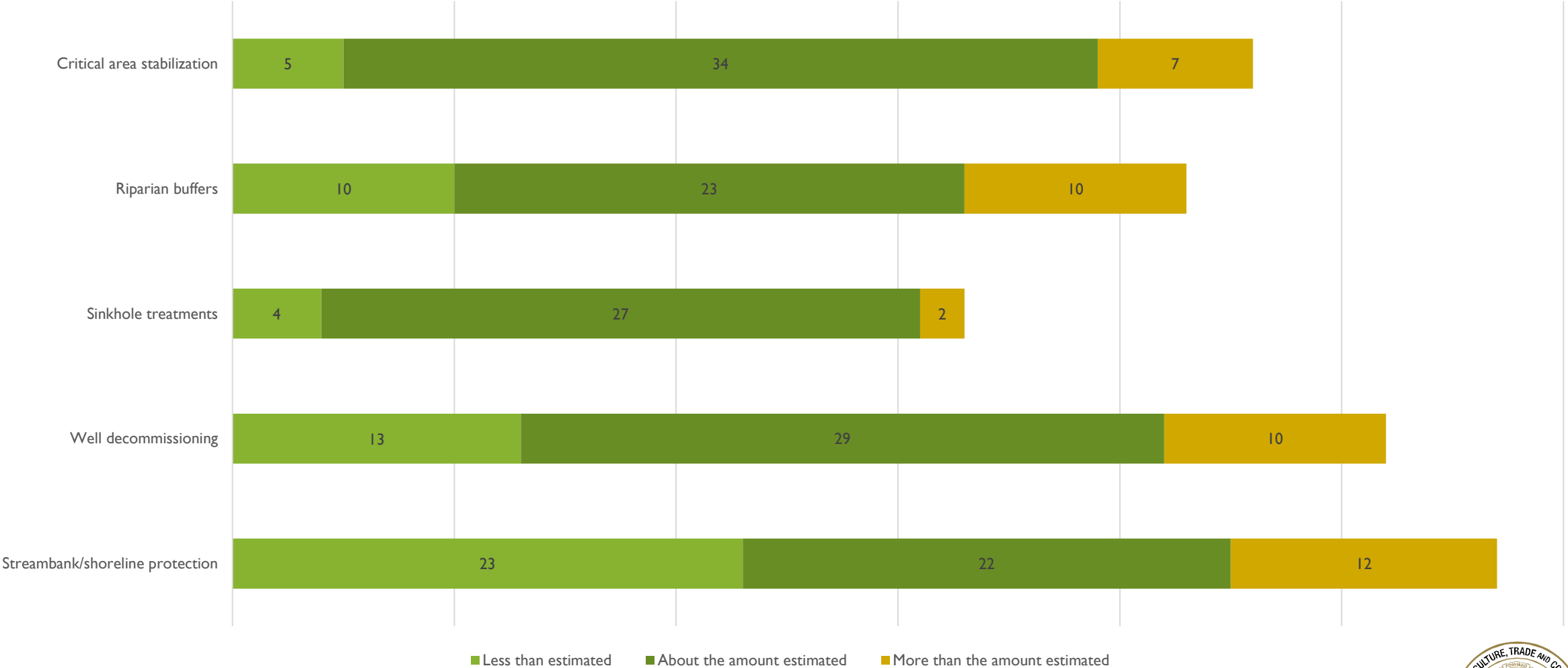


Livestock Practices Installed, Compared to Workplan Estimates

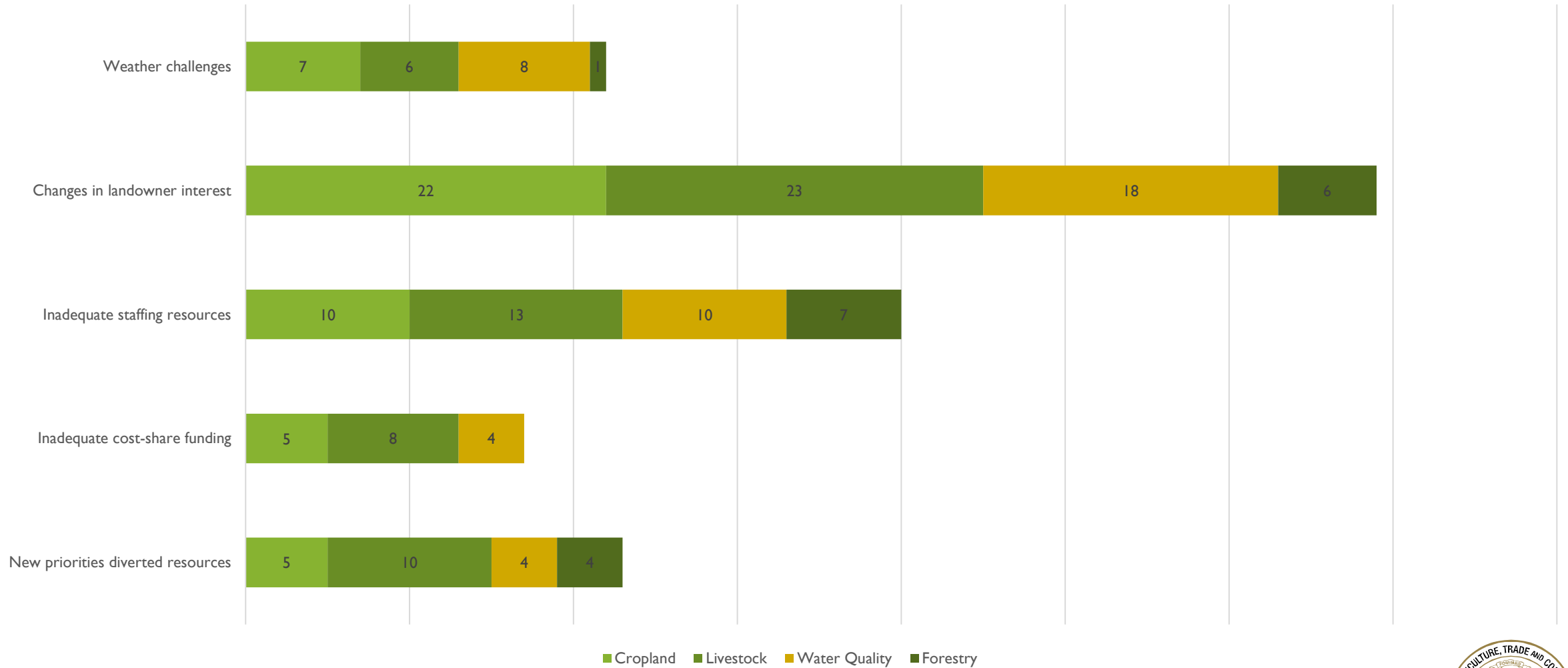




Water Quality Practices Installed, Compared to Workplan Estimates
