Per s. 92.14 (17), Wis. Stats., the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) has partnered with the U.S. Department of Agriculture Risk Management Agency (USDA-RMA) to establish crop insurance rebates for planting cover crops. Interested participants may enroll acres planted in cover crops which will be planted to an insurable crop the following growing season. Eligible applicants will receive a \$5 per acre insurance rebate on the year's crop insurance invoice for acres enrolled and verified in the program on a first come first served basis until program funding is exhausted.

Submitting a completed application form to the Department is mandatory for participation in the Cover Crop Rebate program. Personal information you provide may be used for purposes other than that for which it was originally collected. Wis. Stat. § 15.04(1)(m). The department may conduct inspections to verify that recipients of a crop insurance premium rebate are in compliance with the provisions s. 94.14(17), Wis. Stats., and any rules promulgated under that subsection.

Funding will be provided through USDA-RMA as an insurance rebate through the normal crop insurance processes, taking into consideration the insured percentage share. For producers farming on shares, please submit ONLY ONE application per cover cropped acreage, even if multiple people and/or policies apply.
