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Introduction

Wisconsin's county and district fairs are an integral part of communities, bringing together producers and consumers and uniting rural and urban people in an enjoyable activity. Fairs provide educational agricultural displays to engage fairgoers of all ages. Serving as a community showplace, fairs offer informational exhibits, entertainment, and the opportunity for youth and adults to work and volunteer together.

Fairs provide community connection. Individuals can enjoy diverse activities and create memories, while youth gain experience and mentorship. Communities also receive economic benefits through increased tourism, job creation, and local economic boosts, as well as a platform for celebrating traditions and fostering local pride.

Wisconsin's County and District Fairs History

- The first Wisconsin county fair was held in Waukesha on July 4, 1842.
- The Walworth County Agricultural Society was adopted in 1842, but their first fair was in October 1850.
- State aid to fairs was first appropriated by the Wisconsin Legislature in 1856.
- Wisconsin began requiring fair annual reports in 1858.
- District fairs in Wisconsin were first started in 1897 with the establishment of the Northern Wisconsin State Fair.
- By 1900, Wisconsin had 55 county fairs.
- Today, Wisconsin has 73 state-aided fairs. Three counties currently do not have a fair (Menomonee, Milwaukee, and Pepin); and four counties have two fairs (Columbia, Grant, Juneau, and Marathon).

Why Does Wisconsin Need County and District Fairs?



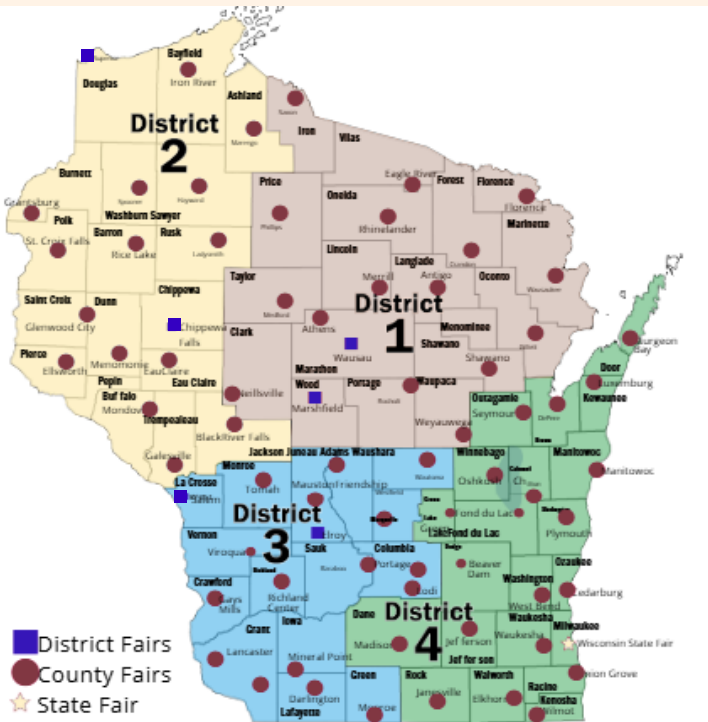
As current and future generations are becoming more distant from the farm, there is a need to increase agricultural awareness and educate consumers.

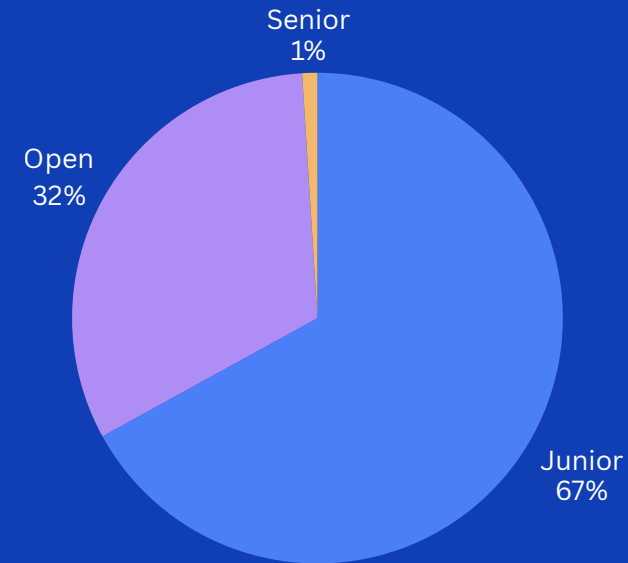

DATCP's Role in County and District Fairs

Under Wis. Stat. § 93.07(22), DATCP has a Fairs Coordinator in the Division of Agricultural Development who serves as the link between state government and Wisconsin's county and district fairs. Statutorily required work includes administering and distributing state aid for fair premiums (Wis. Stat. § 93.23); following prescribed uniform premium lists; and required 30-day statements. DATCP abides by ch. ATCP 160 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code to implement state laws related to fairs. In addition, DATCP oversees the licensing program for Fairs Judges; including an annual training for new judges.

The Fairs Coordinator serves as primary contact for all matters of the 73 county and district fair organizations as it relates to the state government. In addition to the above, they also work with fairs to:

- Improve exhibits and signage to better showcase and educate fairgoers about Wisconsin agriculture.
- Answer questions regarding premium books, split fair dates, required fairs reporting, and fair evaluations.
- Serve as a liaison to provide DATCP and other state agency resources for the fairs (examples: animal health rule updates, food safety or weights/measures regulations, financial reporting, etc.).
- Distribute an annual Fairs Entertainment Brochure with Wisconsin Association of Fairs (WAF).
- Create a DATCP Annual Fairs Report.
- Serve as a liaison to WAF and IAFE, providing DATCP updates at WAF Convention and District Meetings.
- Work with 4-H, FFA, and other fair-exhibiting organizations in cooperation with UW-Extension.

How do fairs value DATCP?

In a recent Wisconsin Association of Fairs (WAF) survey sent to the 73 Fair organizations, fair personnel stated a top reason they attend spring and fall district meetings is to get updates from DATCP on:

- Regulatory issues, i.e. animal health, food safety, etc.
- Industry updates and best practices.
- Networking and idea sharing.

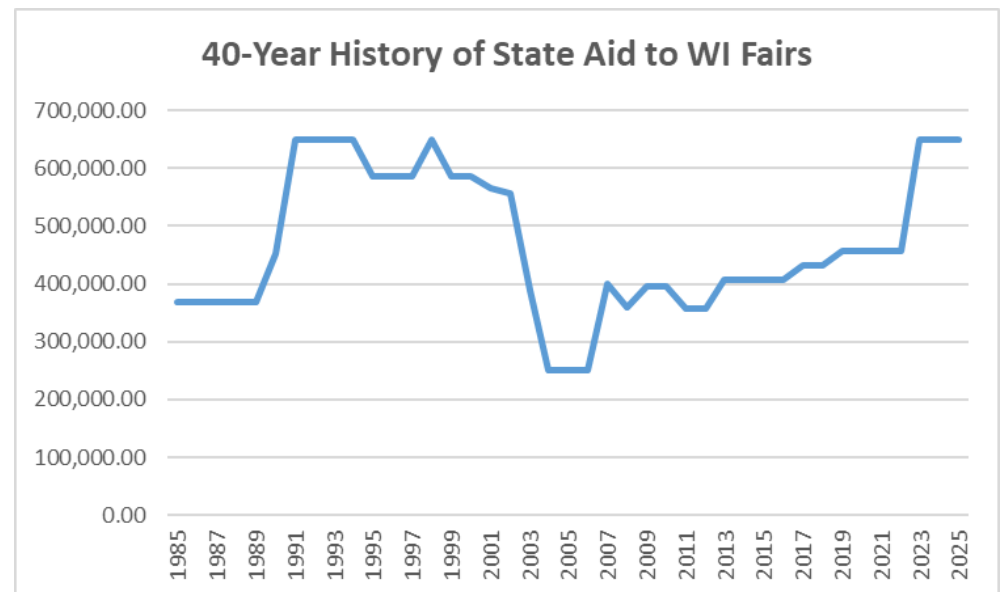
The Fairs Entertainment Schedule is a promotional tool listing annual dates, location, and daily entertainment for each fair in Wisconsin. It is printed and distributed through collaboration between DATCP and the Wisconsin Association of Fairs.

Licensed fair judges can update their information, sign up for new departments, or change their fair judge status by emailing datcpfairs@wisconsin.gov.

State Aid for County and District Fairs

The source of 2025 State of Wisconsin aid funding for county and district fairs is General Purpose Revenue. The uniform premium list, established in ATCP 160 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, provides the basis for distribution of \$650,000 in premium aid to fairs.

State aid is paid on a formula established by the legislature in 2007 in Wis. Stat. § 20.115(4)(b). Premiums are paid to Junior, Open, and Senior Citizen classes, with \$20,000 maximum for each fair. Wisconsin Stat. § 93.23(1) (a) directs money to be paid to fairs by request only. State aid paid to each fair is based on premiums paid in the previous year's fair season.
