What Documentation Do I Need to Show Poultry and Farm-Raised Game Birds?

Young Birds and Eggs

Four (4) testing options:

1

Individual Test Report



- Valid for 90 days
- Testing only mature birds going to fair*
- WI Individual Poultry Test Report

WI Tested Flock



- Valid for one (1) year
- Testing all mature birds in a flock*
- WI Tested Flock Form

WI Associate Flock



- Valid if all birds in flock are from an NPIP, WI Tested and/or Associate Flock
- No annual testing required
- WI Associate Flock Form
- Supporting documentation**

National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP)



- Annual testing as required for program participation
- Supporting Documentation**

4

*Poultry are considered mature when four (4) months of age or older or six (6) months or older for turkeys.

Turkeys 6mo or older must be tested for both *Pullorum-Typhoid* AND *Mycoplasma gallisepticum*.

**Supporting documentation includes:

If from NPIP or NPIP Affiliate Flock:

- NPIP Flock Certificate OR
- Invoice and/or document with NPIP seals OR
- VS Form 9-3 and copy of NPIP certificate from seller

If from WI Associate Flock:

- Invoice or documentation showing that all of the birds or bird eggs in the flock were acquired directly from a Wisconsin Tested Flock, Wisconsin Associate Flock, NPIP flock, or an NPIP affiliate flock.
