H5N1

FDA did testing of finished products.

- 297 samples
- 60 of those samples tested positive for the presence of virus particles
- None tested positive for viable virus

11 samples came from Wisconsin firms – all tested negative

FDA is doing additional testing
-“To fill in the gaps”

FDA is also doing testing of pasteurization effectiveness.

Several research institutes have done or are doing studies.

There are plans to do a sampling of milk prior to pasteurization.

ACASS WORDING

Gone is the five-year time limit and need to reapply

This authorization is valid for as long as the dairy plant operator can show department personnel that in accordance with ATCP 65.23(2)(b), Wis. Adm. Code, they remain in compliance with the reanalysis requirements outlined in 21 CFR 117.170. This section requires Food Safety Plans to be reanalyzed:

- 1) In their entirety at a minimum of once every three years
- 2) In addition, applicable portions must be reanalyzed:
 - a) Whenever you become aware of new information about potential hazards
 - b) After an unanticipated food safety problem
 - c) Whenever you find a preventive control, combination of preventive controls, or the plan as a whole is ineffective.
