NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD Emergency Rule Relating to Hemp and Affecting Small Businesses

The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (Department) announces that, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.24 (4), the Department will hold a public hearing and comment period on its emergency rule to repeal and recreate Wis. Admin. Code ch. ATCP 22, relating to hemp and affecting small businesses.

The Department invites the public to participate in the public hearing on the emergency rule and to provide oral testimony.
