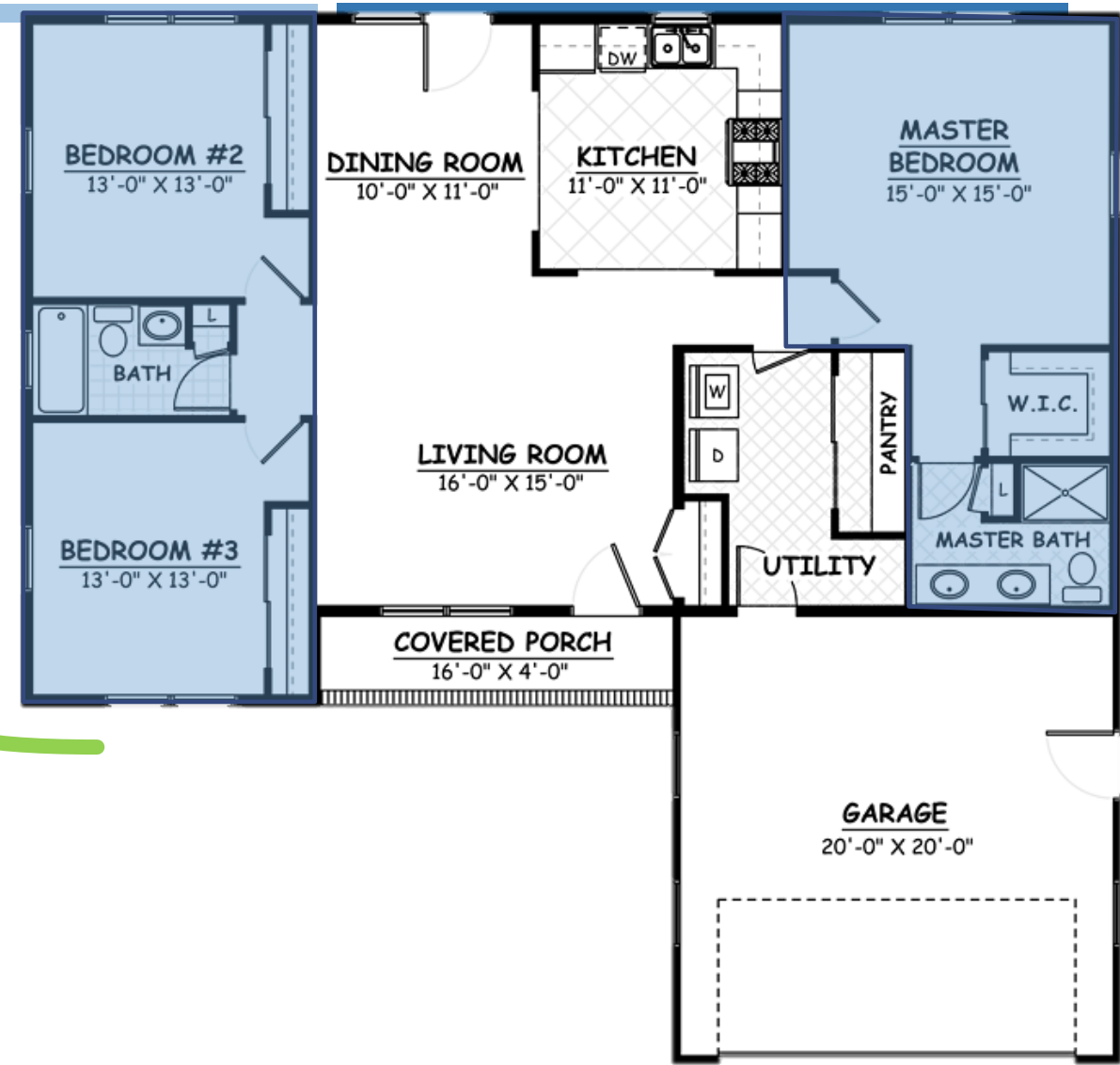

Most common in TRH situation.









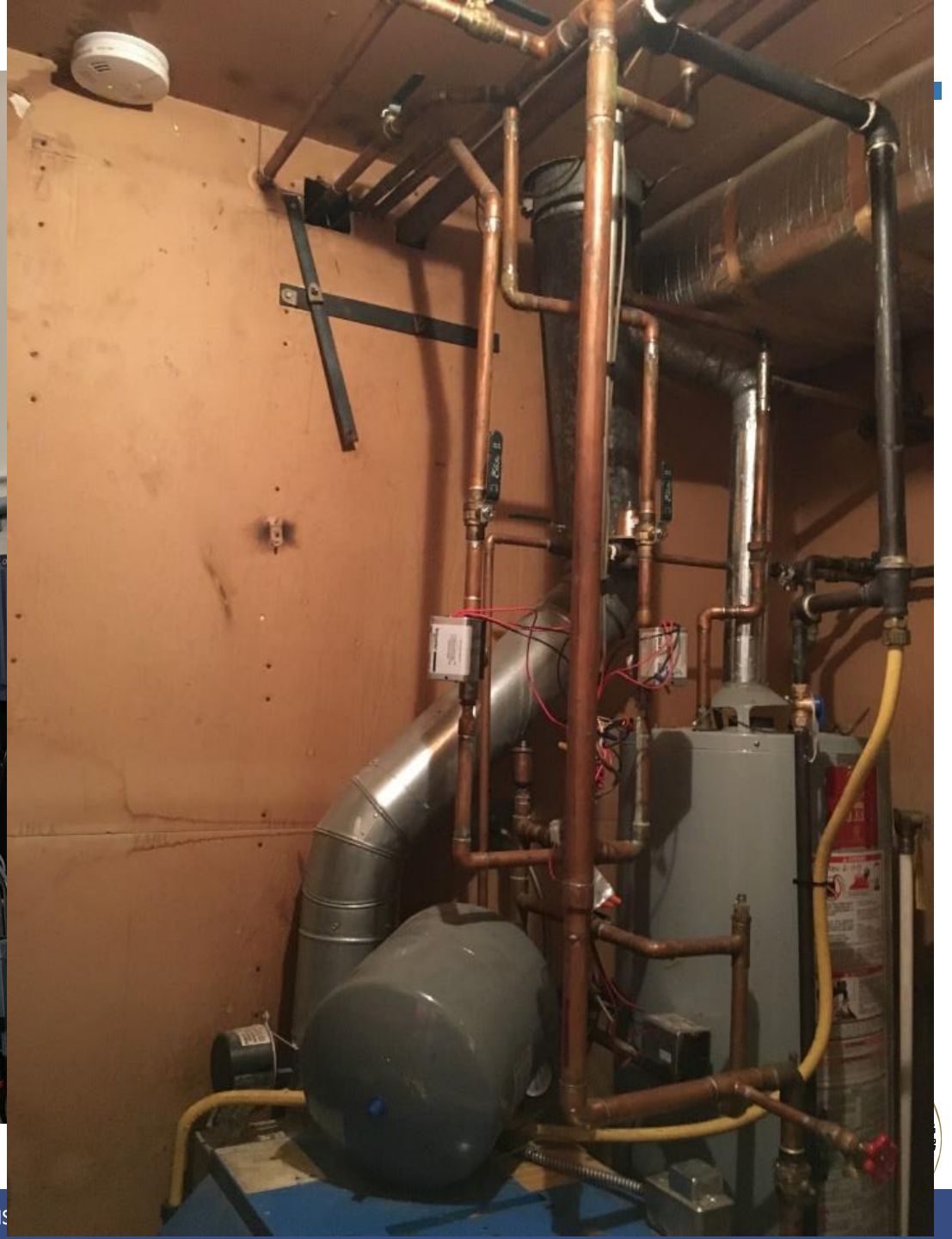
(C) FUEL-BURNING APPLIANCES OUTSIDE OF AN INDIVIDUALLY KEYED UNITS

Most common in hotel/motel situation.









(D) PRIVATE GARAGES

Can be ignored if fuel-burning appliances are present in the TRH.

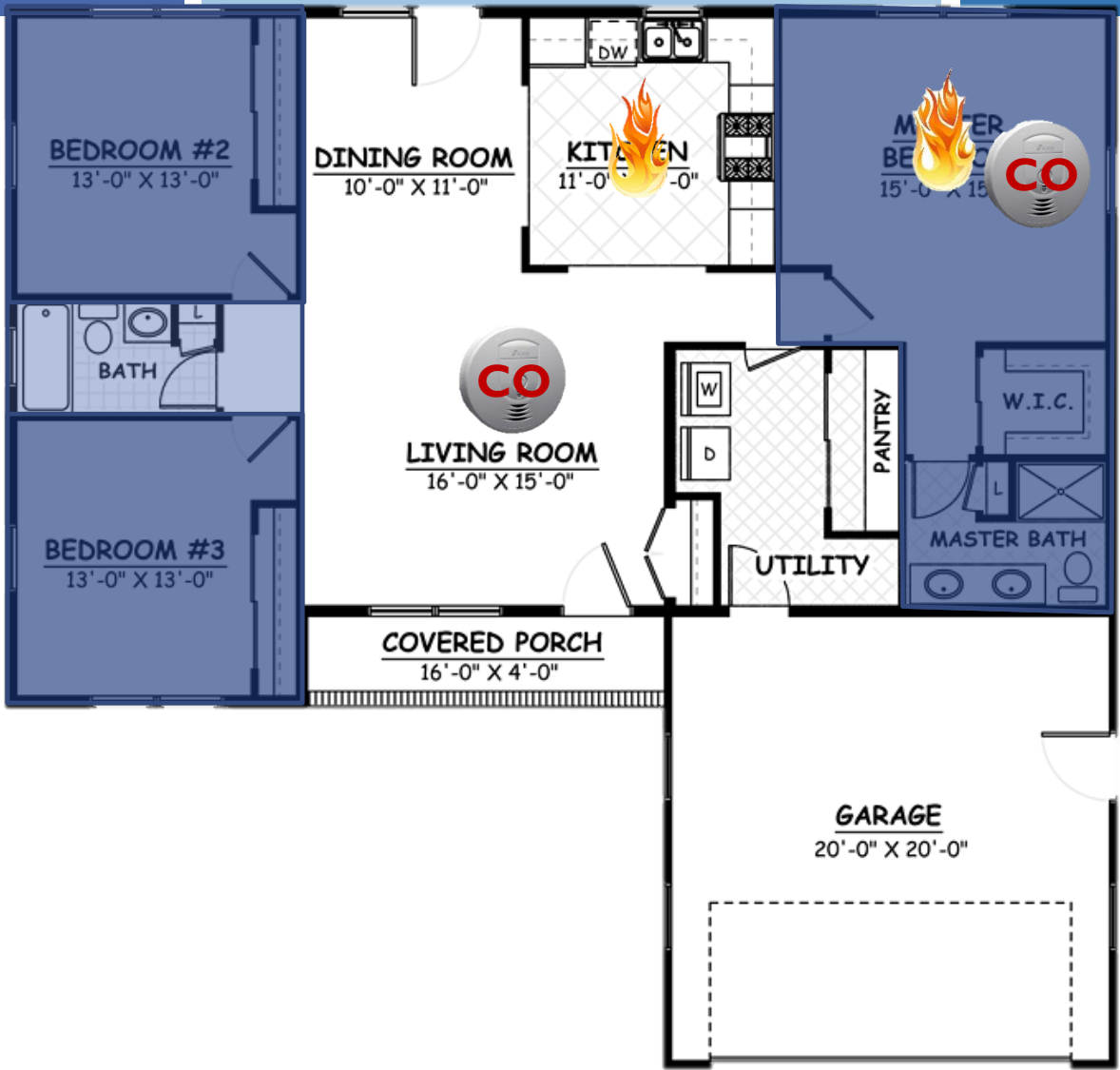
- (b) *FBA within individually keyed unit* already requires CO alarm installation outside each separate sleeping area and in sleeping room if applicable. – more strict

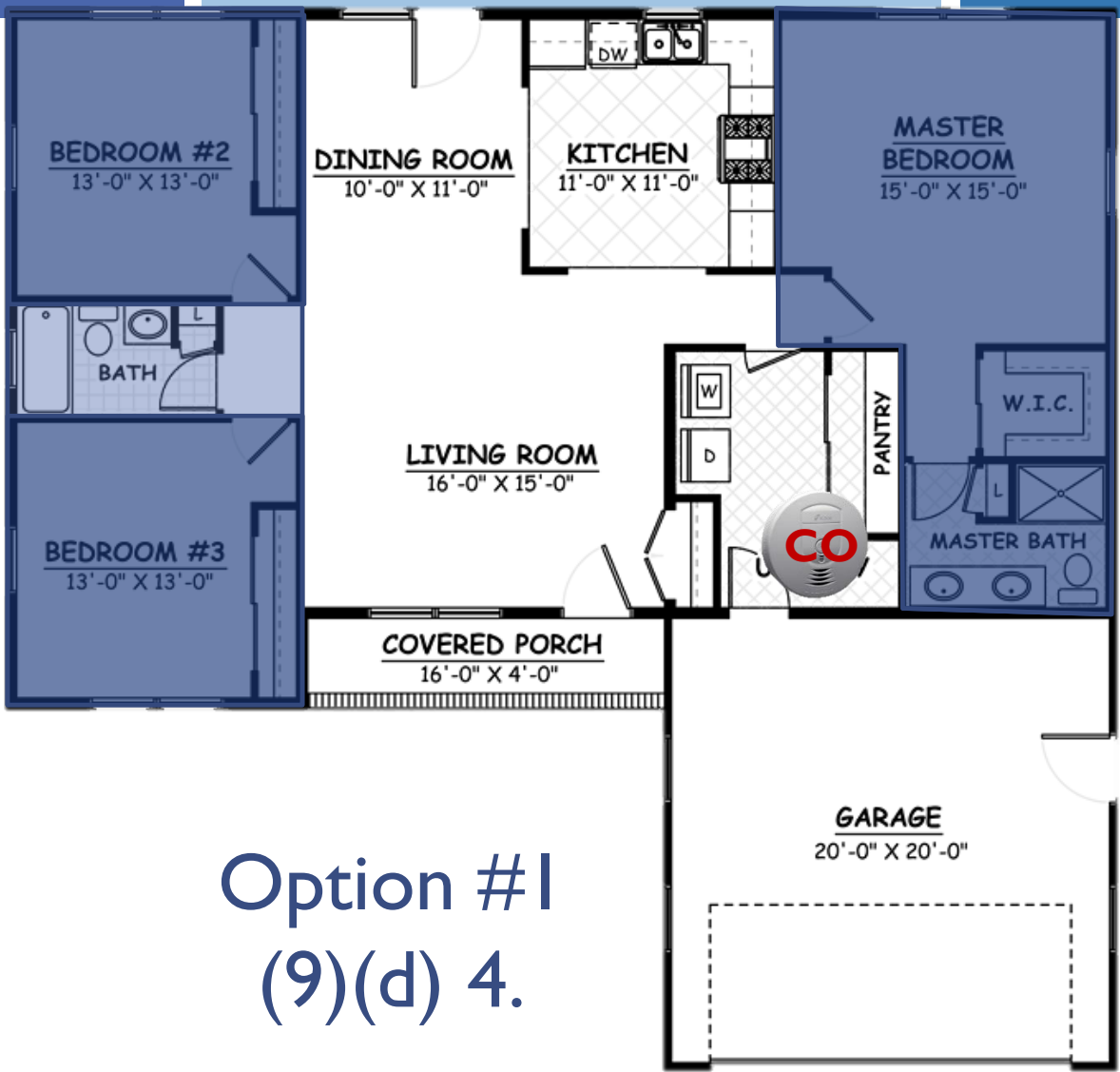

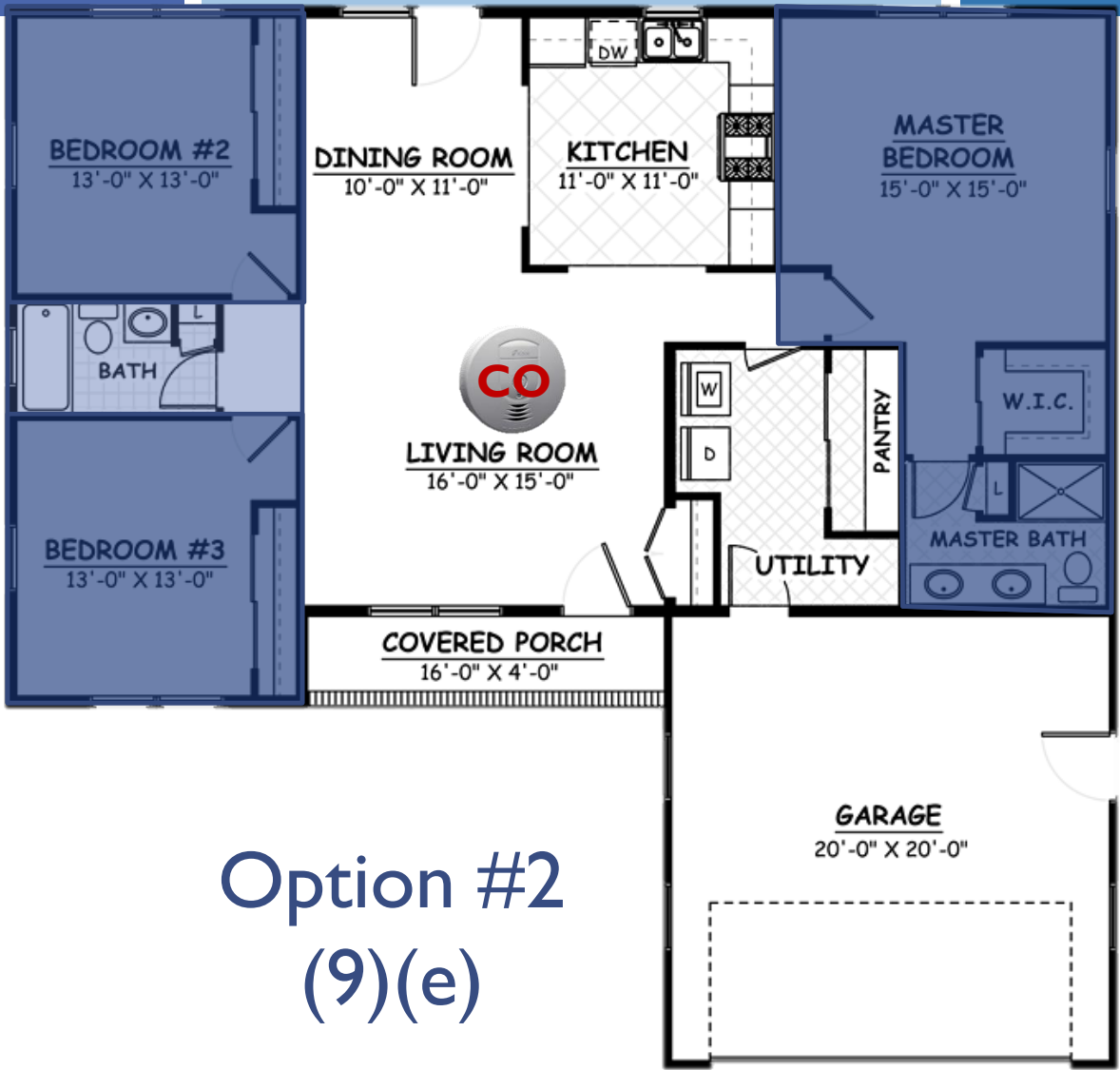

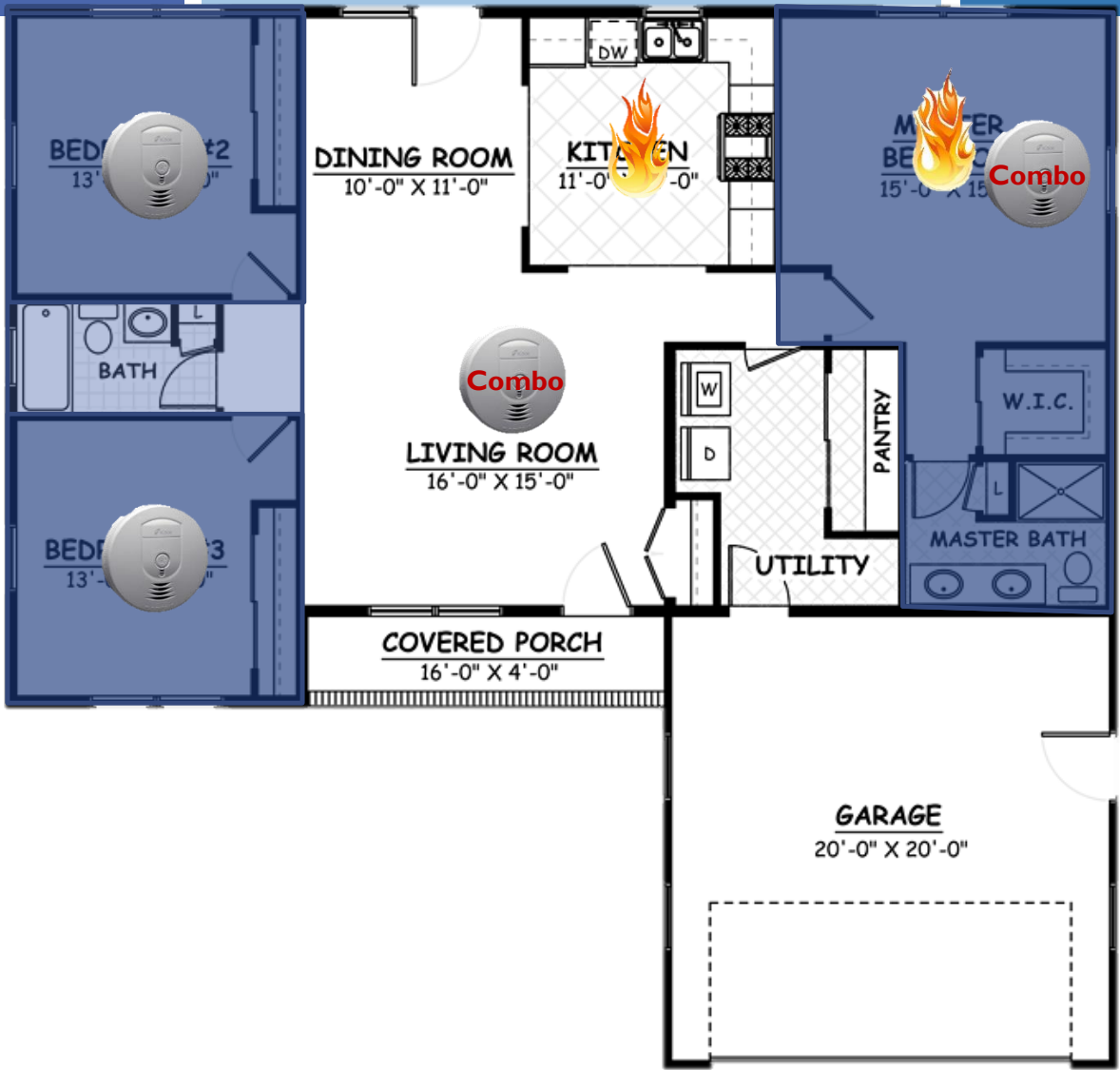
