

H5N1

- FDA running study on raw milk cheeses
 - No positives have been reported to us to date
- Cornell Raw Milk Cheese study
 - Showing that many heat treatments work against this virus
- USDA sampling mandate (National Milk Testing Strategy)
 - Still in discussion phase



H5N1

- The Nevada outbreak
 - Different Strain (D1.1 versus B3.13)
 - · Strain previously identified primarily in birds
 - Primary genotype in North American flyways this fall and winter
 - Some human cases including a death in Louisiana and hospitalization in Canada
 - Does not appear to be farm to farm transfer
 - Farms over 7 miles apart and no cattle movement
 - Appears to be transmitted from birds to cow harder to control
 - Does not change National Milk Testing Strategy





NCIMS

- · 2025 Proposals should be coming out shortly
- Some of the proposed changes

 - Seeking to clarify some Appendix N language
 Allow farm employees to do certain tasks with on-farm, in-line samplers without needing to be a BMWS
 - Request to develop a Farm Practices Committee



OTHER ITEMS

- Testing of Raw milk cheeses for Salmonella, EHEC/STEC, L. mono
- No positive test results to date
- · Drug residue testing has been paused
