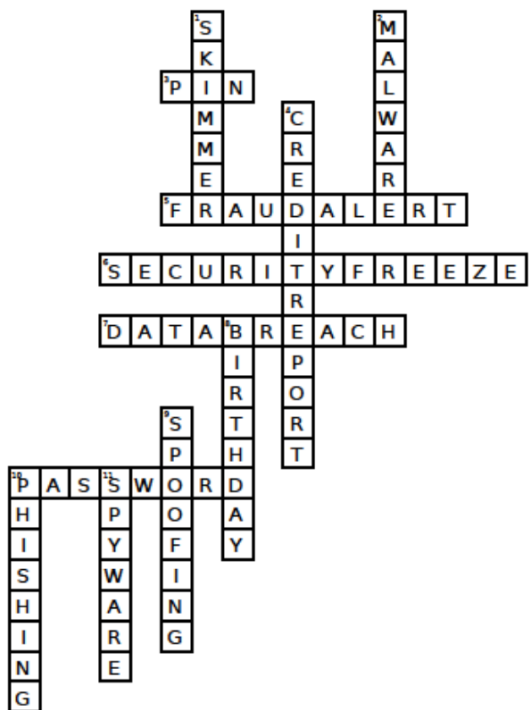


IDENTITY THEFT CROSSWORD
