

MILK PRODUCER LICENSING

- 65.02(2)(b) 15 days to act on a complete application
- Please submit new milk producer application via MyDATCP 1-2 weeks prior to anticipated licensing date.
- Option for a temporary B license only for up to 40 days.
- Timely status changes, e.g., plant transfers and dry/active status.

ATCP 82

- No person may operate a bulk milk tanker unless there is a cleaning tag or other evidence of cleaning.
- Milk sampling procedures (82.12(2)).
 - Dipper
 - Silo
 - In-line sampler

IN-LINE SAMPLER

- At least one individual at the farm is a licensed BMWS.
- Approved in-line sampling device.
- The licensed BMWS trains all personnel who work with any part of the in-line sampling device and maintains records of the training.
- All personnel working with the in-line sampling device follow all manufacturers instructions.

MILK COLLECTION RECORDS

- Legible BMWS unique identifier.
- Milk producer dairy plant identification number.
- BMWS license number.
- Date and time when the milk was sampled and accepted.
- Temperature of the milk when accepted.
- Weight or volume of milk accepted.

SURVEY UPDATES


- Organizational changes with FDA Milk Staff
 - Likely going to complete a large number of milk producer check ratings in 2026.
 - May be done by neighboring Regional Milk Specialists.
- BMWS 2-year inspections
 - Previous inspection did not occur within a 24 month duration.
 - Historically IMS Team only looked for a current inspection.
 - Survey procedures require looking back to ensure inspection did not exceed 24 months.
