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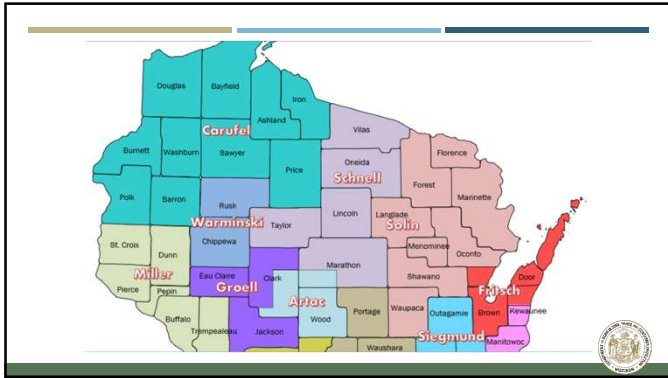

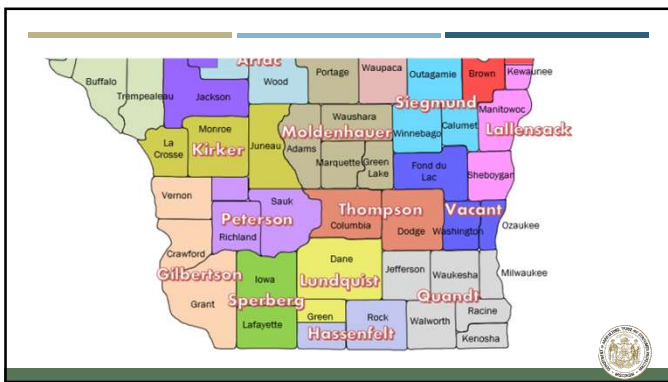

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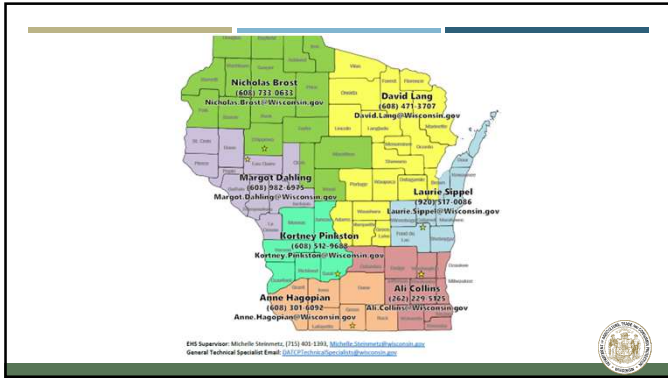

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Cream Cooling

65.54(2)(f) Cream, skim milk, or low-fat milk that have been treated with heat to an extent less than pasteurization, and then shipped in bulk to another dairy plant for use in manufacturing dairy products. Cream, skim milk, and low-fat milk, after being heated to an extent less than pasteurization, shall immediately be cooled to a temperature of 45° F. or less.




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Current Issues

- "all in one cleaners"
- Sanitizers must be registered with the EPA and have directions for use with food contact surfaces.
- Cheesemaker requirements to include cheeses under 21 CFR part 133 – Cheeses and Related Cheese Products.
 - E.g., Cottage cheese, pasteurized processed cheese, cheese spread, and cream cheese.




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Guidance Documents


- Electronic Record Requirements
 - Overview of PMO Appendix H
 - Electronic data collection, storage, recording and reporting.
 - Does not include public health controls, i.e., pasteurization.
- Water Flush
 - Flushing Grade A milk with water.
 - Protections need to be in place to ensure Grade A milk is not contaminated with water.
