NOTES ON SWRM

2025 Joint Applications were due April 15

SWRM Bond funding is now called Structural Funds

- Source of funding in the state budget changed
- The allocated General Purpose Revenue (GPR) Funds will be used the same way as Bond funds with the same requirements

NOTES ON SWRM

- SEG Funding
 - Can be used for cropping practices (tillage, cover crops, etc)
 without DATCP approval. Requires a Nutrient Management
 checklist for reimbursement
 - Up to 50% of SEG award can be used for structural practices if:
 - ✓ Project is in support of NM plan implementation
 - ✓ Draft contract is provided to DATCP
 - ✓ Preapproval issued by DATCP

SWRM Grant Program for Counties

The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) awards annual Soil and Water Resource Management (SWRM) grants to county conservation committees and other cooperators. These grants assist in funding county conservation staff and cost-share conservation practices installed by producers with assistance through their county. Participating counties have an allocation process for these grants approved by DATCP. The process is outlined in the SWRM grant manual below.

NITROGEN OPTIMIZATION GRANTS



- Program is designed to support on-farm research where producers start with their own questions and are able to work with research experts to complete projects on their land
- Awards for the second cycle were just announced:
 - Manure, cranberries, sunflowers, cover crops, tillage varieties and more will be studied

COVER CROP INSURANCE REBATE PROGRAM

- Second year of the program
 - Fully utilized award for 2023
- \$5/acre rebate on crop insurance for cover crop planting
- Acres cannot have received costshare or incentives from other state or federal government programs
