



## Wind Erosion

- Wind erosion is a major resource concern
- Cost share for cover crops and wind breaks
- Partner with Central Wisconsin Windshed Partnership – CWWP



## Stormwater Runoff

- Have a stormwater ordinance for urban areas
- Implement agricultural stormwater runoff practices
  - Ex: grassed waterways and grade stabilization



# Non-metallic Mining

- 10 active unreclaimed mining sites
- Newly updated non-metallic mining ordinance


# Animal Waste Management

- Have an animal waste management ordinance
- Cost share manure storage and nutrient management plans
- 48,398 nutrient management 590 plan acres



# Farmland Preservation

- 9 townships with Farmland Preservation zoning eligibility
- Two active FPP plans





## Shoreline Erosion

- Shoreland ordinance
- Site evaluation and survey
- Promote cost sharing practices through DATCP and DNR
- 2021 - 13 shoreline visits
- 2022 - 16 shoreline visits already

# Surface & Groundwater Quality

- Monitor for blue-green algae blooms
- E. coli sample at county owned beaches
- Citizen Lake Monitoring Network
- Well Sampling Program
- Farmers of the Roche-A-Cri
- Fourteen Mile 9 Key Element Plan



# Invasive Species

- Monitor terrestrial (on land) and aquatic invasive species
- Work with private landowners to control and manage invasive species
- Partner with Central Wisconsin Invasives Partnership - CWIP
