POLICY

The Division of Animal Health, Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection will accept as proof for a current negative Equine Infectious Anemia Test any of the following certificates:

1. The original copy of the federal Equine Infectious Anemia Laboratory Test form:
 - VS Form 10-11 (May 2000)
 - VS Form 10-11 (April 1990), or
 - VS Form 10-11T or USDA approved electronic equivalent.
2. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection completed by an Accredited Veterinarian, on which the EIA test results, the laboratory that performed the testing and the date the testing was completed are listed.
3. A Global Vet Link (GVL) Equine Infectious Anemia Test electronic form.
