USING -

- The free white button 840 official RFID tags are for use with cattle (including steers) and bison only.
- Tags are for use only in your own animals. They are not to be shared, sold or used at other farms.

TAGGERS & READERS

- Use a tagger from the same manufacturer as the tags.
- A limited number of Allflex and Datamars taggers are available from DATCP for first-time orders while supplies last. To request a tagger, contact Paul Johann at paul.johann@wisconsin.gov when you get your tags.
- Taggers may also be purchased directly from the manufacturer or their distributor.
- Readers can be purchased from manufacturers or animal health supply distributors.
