







- YTD Q2 exports: \$2.0 billion, second highest on record.
- The top 10 markets make up 80% of the total.
 - Mexico and Netherlands are up double digits.
- USDA forecast projects a decline in agricultural exports by the end of 2023.



- YTD Q2 exports: Second highest on record, \$30 million above 2021.
- The top 10 products are 69% of the total.
- Sauces and yeasts, soybeans, and meat are up double digits.
- Wisconsin is 10th in the US for agricultural exports, year to date.




- Total dairy exports YTD Q2: \$254 million
- The top five countries are 69% of the total.
 - China and Mexico are up.
- The next five countries of the top
 10 are all up, four in double digits.
- Japan and Korea are down, affected by a strong dollar to the yen and won



- Total meat exports YTD Q2: \$411 million
- The top five countries make up 70% of the total.
 - Japan and Korea are up despite the strong dollar to the yen and won.
- The next five countries of the top
 10 are all up, three in double digits.
- Turkey is up over 450%, driven by live animal exports.



- Total crop exports YTD Q2: \$1.34 billion.
- The top five countries make up 53% of the total.
 - Mexico (soybeans and sauces)
 and the Netherlands (enzymes,
 prepared vegetables) are both up double digits.
- Overall, soybeans, prepared cereals, and milling products have double digit increases to date.




