Monthly Prices

The average price received by farmers for **corn** during October 2025 in Wisconsin was \$3.79 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was 19 cents below the September price and 9 cents below October 2024.

The October 2025 average price received by farmers for **soybeans**, at \$9.56 per bushel, was 15 cents above the September price and 34 cents below the October 2024 price.

The October average **oat** price per bushel, at \$3.75, was 23 cents above September and 11 cents below October 2024.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$119.00 per ton in October. This was \$10.00 above the September price and \$18.00 below the October 2024 price. The October 2025 **alfalfa hay** price, at \$131.00, was \$14.00 above the previous month and \$16.00 below October 2024. The average price received for **other hay** during October was \$93.00 per ton. This was \$5.00 above the September price and \$22.00 below October last year.





Milk Prices

The Wisconsin all milk price for October 2025 was \$19.50 per hundredweight (cwt) according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service - *Agricultural Prices* report. This was \$0.80 below last month's price and \$5.60 below last October's price. The U.S. all milk price for October was \$20.00 per cwt, \$0.50 higher than Wisconsin's price but \$0.40 lower than last month's U.S. price.






Milk Production

Milk production in Wisconsin during November 2025 totaled 2.64 billion pounds, up 2 percent from the previous November according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Milk Production* report. The average number of milk cows during November, at 1.28 million head, was up 14,000 from November 2024. Monthly production per cow averaged 2,065 pounds, up 15 pounds from last November.



Milk Cows and Production – 24 Selected States: November 2024 and 2025




Chickens & Eggs

Wisconsin egg production during November 2025 was 94.8 million eggs, down 54 percent from the previous November, according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Chickens and Eggs* report. The average number of all layers on hand during November 2025 was 5.10 million, down 36 percent from last year. Eggs per 100 layers for November was 1,858, down 28 percent from a year ago.
