- Mail all documents along with license fee to DATCP lock box

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DATCP PROCESSING

- 1. Applications materials are received and processed.
- 2. Appropriate staff are notified an application is in process: . Supervisor, Sanitarian, and Dairy Technical Specialist (DTS)
 - 2 Milk Sanitation Rating Officer if IMS listed facility

3. DTS completes plan review.

LICENSING INSPECTION

- I. Requirements:
 - Application materials complete
 - 2. DTS plan review
- 2. Sanitarian will contact to schedule licensing inspection within 40 days after receipt of a completed application
 - A joint licensing inspection will be conducted by assigned sanitarian and DTS
 - Milk Sanitation Rating Officer if IMS listed
 - If facility and process meet ATCP 65 requirements, a dairy plant license will be issued
 - If ATCP 65 requirements are not satisfactory, the license will be denied and the application process restarts

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
